Year 1 (Sophomore Year)

RESEARCH EXPERIENCE AND EXPECTATIONS

- Optional community events and workshops
- Summer research immersion embedded in lab for 10 weeks (20–40 hrs/week, based on student choice)

Year 2 (Junior Year)

RESEARCH EXPERIENCE AND EXPECTATIONS

- Seminar course with the full cohort (approx. 3 hrs/week)
- Optional community events and workshops
- Independent study credits or hourly wage for 6–9 hrs/week in lab
- Identify honors thesis mentor and focal interest
- Summer research immersion embedded in lab and YPAR cohort for 10 weeks (20–40 hrs/week, based on student choice)

Year 3 (Senior Year)

RESEARCH EXPERIENCE AND EXPECTATIONS

- Seminar course with the full cohort (approx. 3 hrs/week)
- Optional community events and workshops
- Independent mentored research project
- Submission of honors application in the fall semester
- Capstone of honors thesis and oral defense with examining committee that includes the thesis advisor, one of the departmental representatives to the Honors Council, and a faculty member outside the Department of Psychology and Neuroscience
- Maximum 3 credits of Senior Thesis in spring semester
- Mentorship to support graduate school applications and grant submissions (e.g. NSF)
- Opportunity to attend/present at a conference
- Graduation celebration (20–40 hrs/week, based on student choice)
