Inclusive and supportive learning environments in pandemic times...and what we can learn from undergraduate LAs

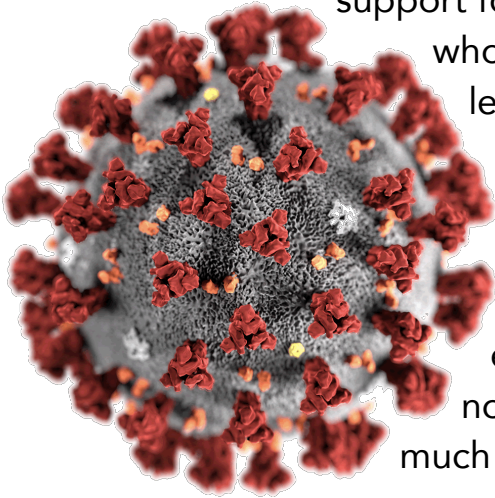
