## Conditions of a Locality Search Request

### Request Submittal

All locality search requests, including any attachments, must be submitted to a collection manager of the Paleontology Section of the University of Colorado Museum of Natural History (CUMNH). All requests will be reviewed and processed by both collection managers of the Paleontology Section of the CUMNH. After being processed, the requestor will be provided with the results of their request. Please allow two weeks for a locality search request to be processed.

### Search Results

All requestors will receive basic locality information for the localities that are found within their project area. This basic locality information includes the following (where known): locality number, locality name, geography (state, county), geological age (period, epoch, age, biostratigraphy zone), stratigraphy (group, formation, member), the number of specimens found at the locality, and the taxon types found at the locality (e.g. eggshell, invertebrate, plant, trace, or vertebrate). Only requestors with a CDOT, federal, or state permit can receive more detailed locality information for the localities that are found within their project area. All requests for more detailed locality information must be made to a collection manager of the Paleontology Section of the CUMNH. Please allow two weeks for a request for more detailed locality information to be processed.

### Fee

The CUMNH charges a fee to process locality search requests. This fee is assessed to the requestor regardless of whether localities are present in their project area or not. The fee is \$50 per project needing a locality search and \$50 per hour after the first hour. Invoices will be attached to the locality search results.
