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"Recipe Halloween "Clock" From the lab of: CU Wizards



Ingredients

1. 5 small clear cups

2. 5 larger clear cups

3. Hydrogen peroxide From your medicine

cabinet

4. White vinegar

5. Food dye

6. Liquid laundry starch

7. Colorless iodide tincture

8. "Fruit Fresh" ascorbic acid for canning

9. Additional cups and measuring cups

Directions

Put 2 teaspoons of hydrogen peroxide into the larger cups. In a separate cup, add one drop each of red and yellow food dye to $\frac{1}{2}$ cup of vinegar. Put 2 teaspoons of the vinegar mixture into each small cup. Add 10 drops of liquid starch to each small cup. Add 20 drops of iodide tincture to each small cup. In a separate cup, add 1.5 teaspoons of Fruit Fresh to $\frac{1}{2}$ cup of water and dissolve. Add varying amounts of Fruit Fresh to each small cup (5 drops, 8 drops, 10 drops, 13 drops, 16 drops). All at the same time, pour each small cup into one of the larger cups and wait for the color change!

Note: Science can be messy! Proceed with caution!

1. Jack-o-Lantern (plastic or real)

2. Hydrogen peroxide From your
