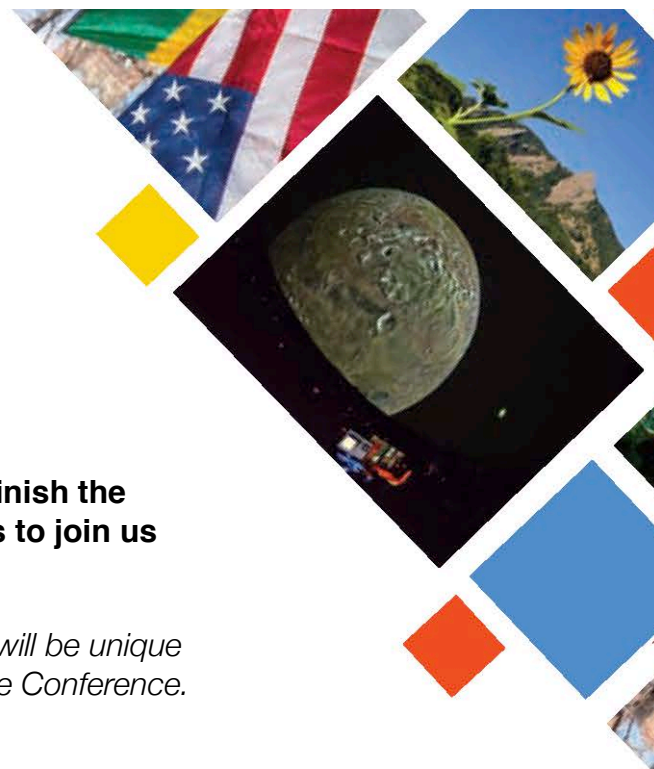


# Conference on WORLD AFFAIRS
