This certificate program is often taken by professionals in various fields and thus presents a unique opportunity for interacting and networking with those individuals online. *Please note that fellowships are currently only available to CU Boulder undergraduate and graduate students who will have completed Organic Chemistry I by September 2026.*

To apply for a fellowship covering registration costs for all three online courses, please send the following materials in a single PDF document to gccs.scholarship@gmail.com.

- Cover page with the following information:
 - Name
 - Major(s), minor(s)
 - Current degree program and expected graduation year
 - Name, address, relationship (must be professional / academic), and contact information for letter of reference writer
- Short response section; please limit each response to 300 words.
 - In accepting this fellowship, you will be committing to enrolling in three contiguous modules over the course of one academic year (approximately 10 hours per week). How do you plan to successfully integrate this coursework into your schedule?
 - What impacts do you predict receiving this certificate will have on your academic and professional career?
 - It is our hope that the concepts and strategies learned in these courses will propagate through departments at CU Boulder. How might you disseminate the knowledge you learn with others?
- Short summary of research experience or interests
- A current curriculum vitae (CV) or resume
- Copy of transcripts (an unofficial copy is acceptable)

Letter of reference: An academic or professional letter of reference must be sent directly to gccs.scholarship@gmail.com by the letter writer.

Application deadline: The application is due by 5 PM on Monday, April 6, 2026, and the letter of recommendation must be received within 48 hours of this deadline (by 5PM on Wednesday, April 8, 2026). Applicants will be notified of the results of their application in May.
