Driving Directions and Ground Transportation

Driving from Denver International Airport

Take Pena Boulevard from the airport to Interstate 70 West. Stay on I-70 West for approximately 120 miles to exit 176 (Vail). At the bottom of the ramp, go 3/4 of the way through the traffic circle so that you go under the highway. At the second traffic circle, stay to the right and take the first exit onto South Frontage Road towards Lionshead. Travel on S. Frontage for about a mile until you drive under the pedestrian bridge that goes over both I-70 and S. Frontage Road then take the immediate left after the pedestrian overpass onto West Lionshead Circle. Keep to the left, and it will take you right to the parking lot of Lion Square Lodge. The whole trip will take between 2 and 1/2 hours.

Shuttle Service

There are several shuttle services from Denver International Airport to Lion Square Lodge. Rates are around \$79 one-way.

Bus Service

The Colorado Department of Transportation operates the [Bustang](#) (West Line) that runs from Union Station in downtown Denver to the Vail Transit Center. It is a twenty-minute walk from the Transit Center to Lion Square Lodge. The fare is \$17 one-way and the schedule is pretty convenient. To get to Union Station you can take the RTD light rail from the airport to Union Station for \$10 one-way. The light rail station is on the south end of the airport terminal. Recently several workshop participants did this and it worked well.
