- 3. In 50-100 words, describe if/how finances affected your program choice, how you have planned and budgeted for your program, and how you will pay for the program if you have unmet need.
- 4. In 50 words or less, provide any additional information about your financial circumstances that should be considered.
- 5. Include the essay with the other required application items.
