4. Save the PDF to your computer.
5. Include the PDF with the rest of the required application items.

**Instructions for Eaton Travel Sabbatical Essay:**

Create a single document titled Eaton Travel Sabbatical Essay on the top line and your name on the second line. Number and address each of the following:

1. In 400 words or less, describe how your study abroad program will enhance your CU educational experience and broaden your knowledge in a cultural and learning environment different from your own.
2. In approximately 100 words, describe how you normally finance your tuition and expenses here at CU. Be specific (i.e. if you split costs with your parents, list what you pay vs. what they pay; if you receive Financial Aid, list specific loans/grants).
3. In 50-100 words, describe if/how finances affected your program choice, how you have planned and budgeted for your program, and how you will pay for the program if you have unmet need.
4. In 50 words or less, provide any additional information about your financial circumstances that should be considered.
5. Include the essay with the other required application items.
