- In our department, these courses are worth four credits. Courses in these subjects at other institutions that transfer to the University of Colorado Boulder as less than three credits are not equivalent to our courses and will not be accepted.
- Courses in these subjects at other institutions that transfer to the University of Colorado Boulder as three credits and which use a textbook approved by our department* will be accepted as equivalent to our courses. However, students will still have to fulfill our credit-hour requirements, perhaps by taking an additional course.
- Courses in these subjects at other institutions that transfer to the University of Colorado Boulder as three credits and which do not use a textbook approved by our department* will have to be evaluated individually by our Undergraduate Curriculum Committee. If accepted as equivalent to our courses, students will still have to fulfill our credit-hour requirements, perhaps by taking an additional class.
- Courses in these subjects at other institutions that transfer to the University of Colorado Boulder as four credits and which use a textbook approved by our department* will be accepted as equivalent to our courses.
- Courses in these subjects at other institutions that transfer to the University of Colorado Boulder as four credits and which do not use a textbook approved by our department* will have to be evaluated individually by our Undergraduate Curriculum Committee.
