- In our department, these courses are worth three credits. Courses in these subjects at other institutions that transfer to the University of Colorado Boulder as less than 2.7 credits are not equivalent to our courses and will not be accepted.
- Courses in these subjects at other institutions that transfer to the University of Colorado Boulder as 2.7 credits or more and which use a textbook approved by our department* will be accepted as equivalent to our courses. Students will receive three credits towards the completion of our major requirements, regardless of the number of transfer credits accepted by the University of Colorado Boulder.
- Courses in these subjects at other institutions that transfer to the University of Colorado Boulder as 2.7 credits or more and which use a textbook that is not approved by our department* will have to be evaluated individually by our Undergraduate Curriculum Committee. If accepted as equivalent to our courses, students will receive three credits towards the completion of our major requirements, regardless of the number of transfer credits accepted by the University of Colorado Boulder.
