EMERGENCY ACTION PLAN

For incidents involving hazardous materials, fires, explosions, or natural gas leaks, take the following actions immediately:

- 1) Life Safety First!**
- 2) Evacuate Immediate Area**
- 3) Pull Fire Alarm**
- 4) Call 911 from a Safe Location**
- 5) Remain Available for Emergency Personnel**

Everyone should familiarize themselves with the quickest exit route from the building, as well as the locations and proper operation of fire extinguishers, fire alarm pull stations, emergency showers and eyewashes, and first aid kits BEFORE an accident or incident occurs.
