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



After Emerald's building redesign, the schoolyard was left with few elements, creating a lack of engagement and excitement for students.

Mission Statement


Activate the current schoolyard by telling the story of Emerald Elementary's diverse cultural identity through nature play, inclusive sensory elements, and learning.




Program Diagram



Front Range Elevation








Arctic Area Perspective
