DESIGN OBJECTIVES

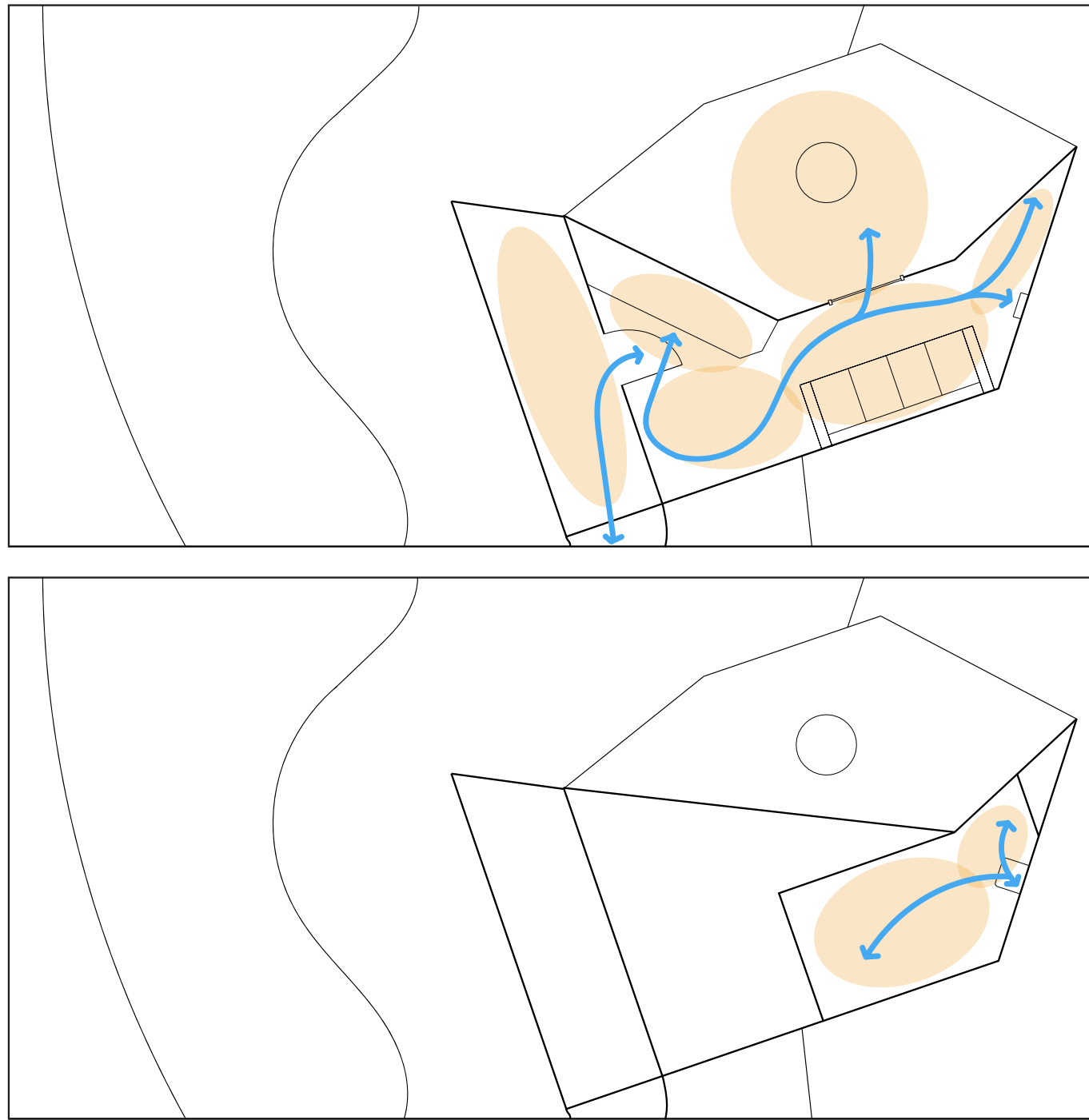
- Create efficient workspace for artwork and photography

PROJECT STATEMENT

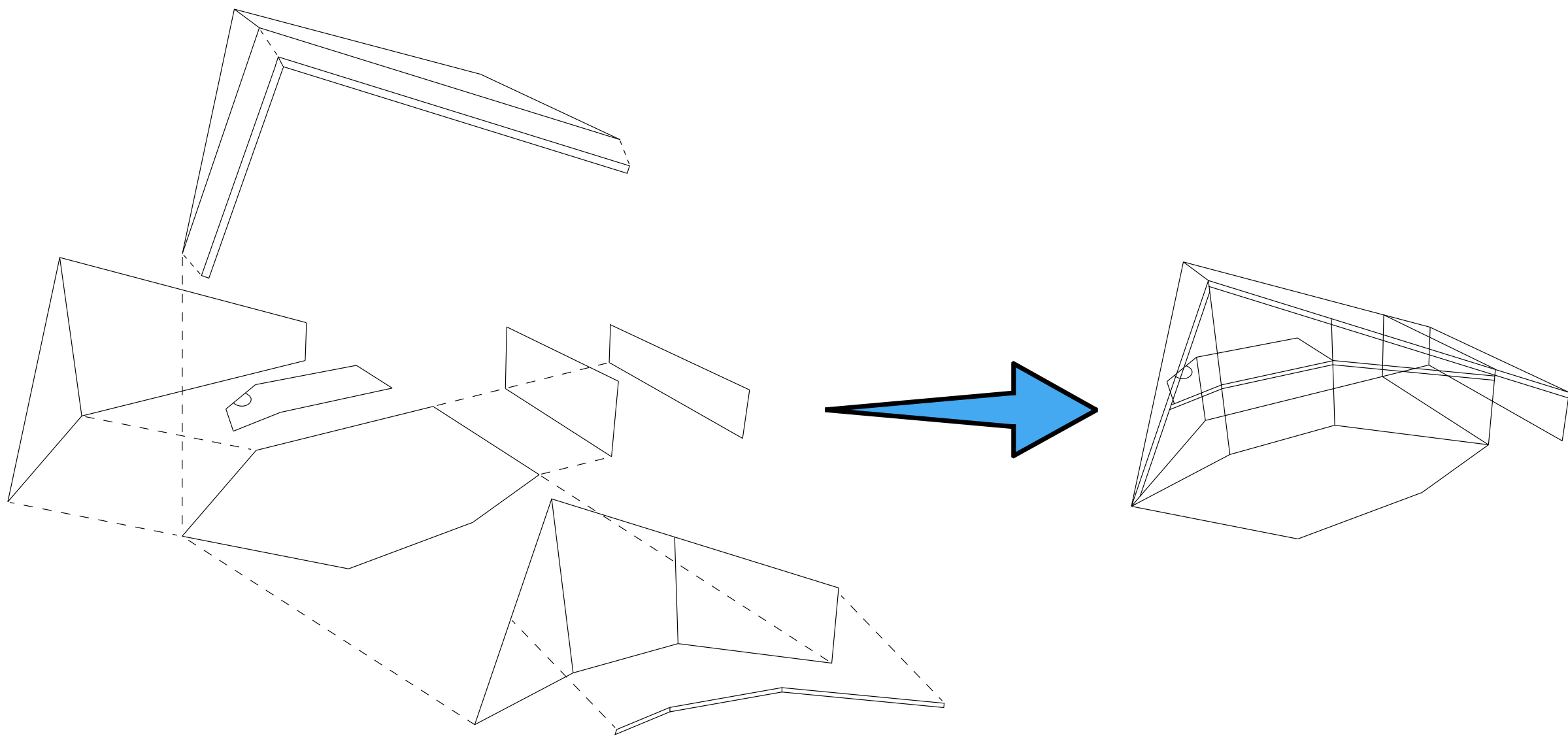

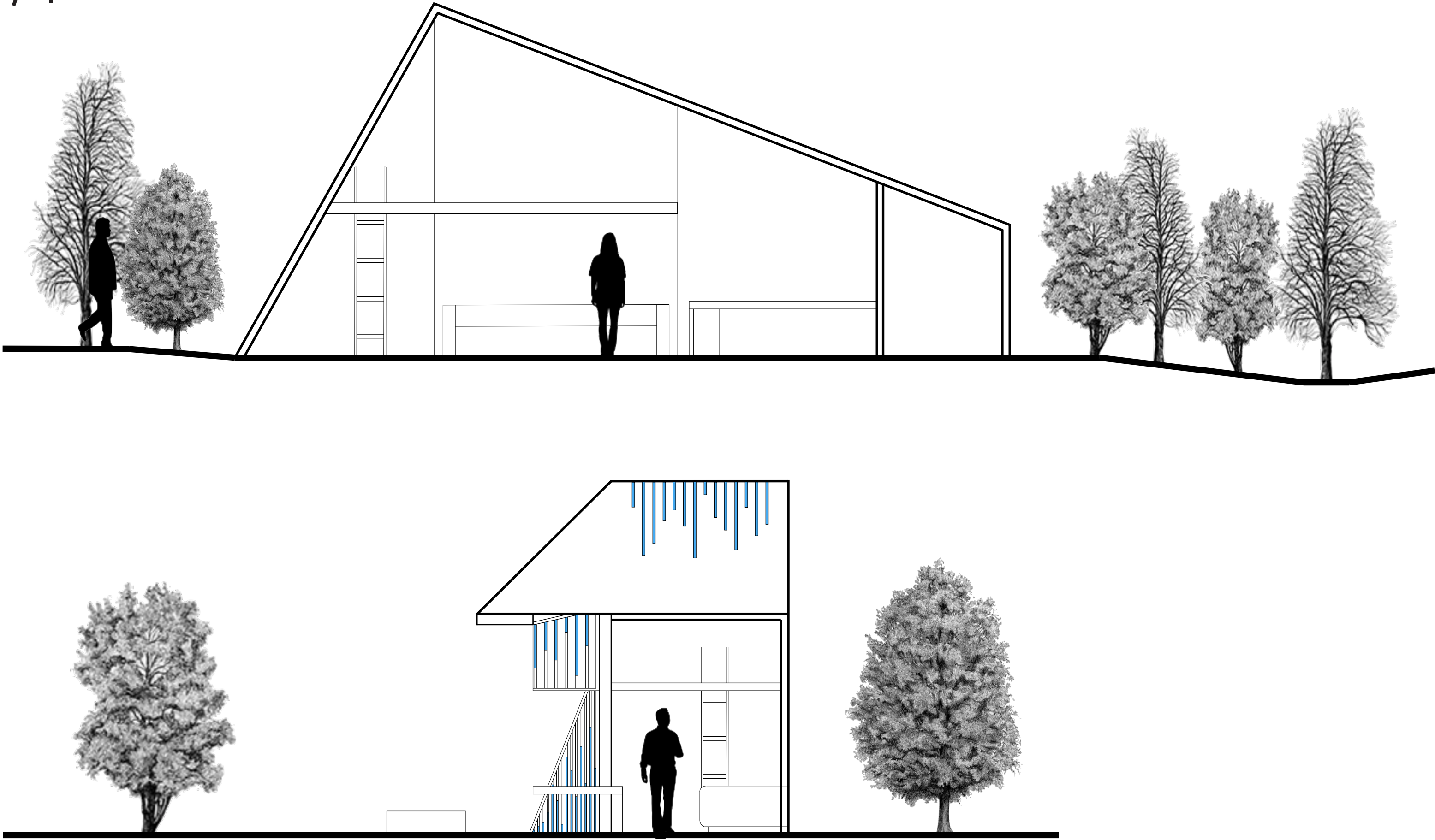

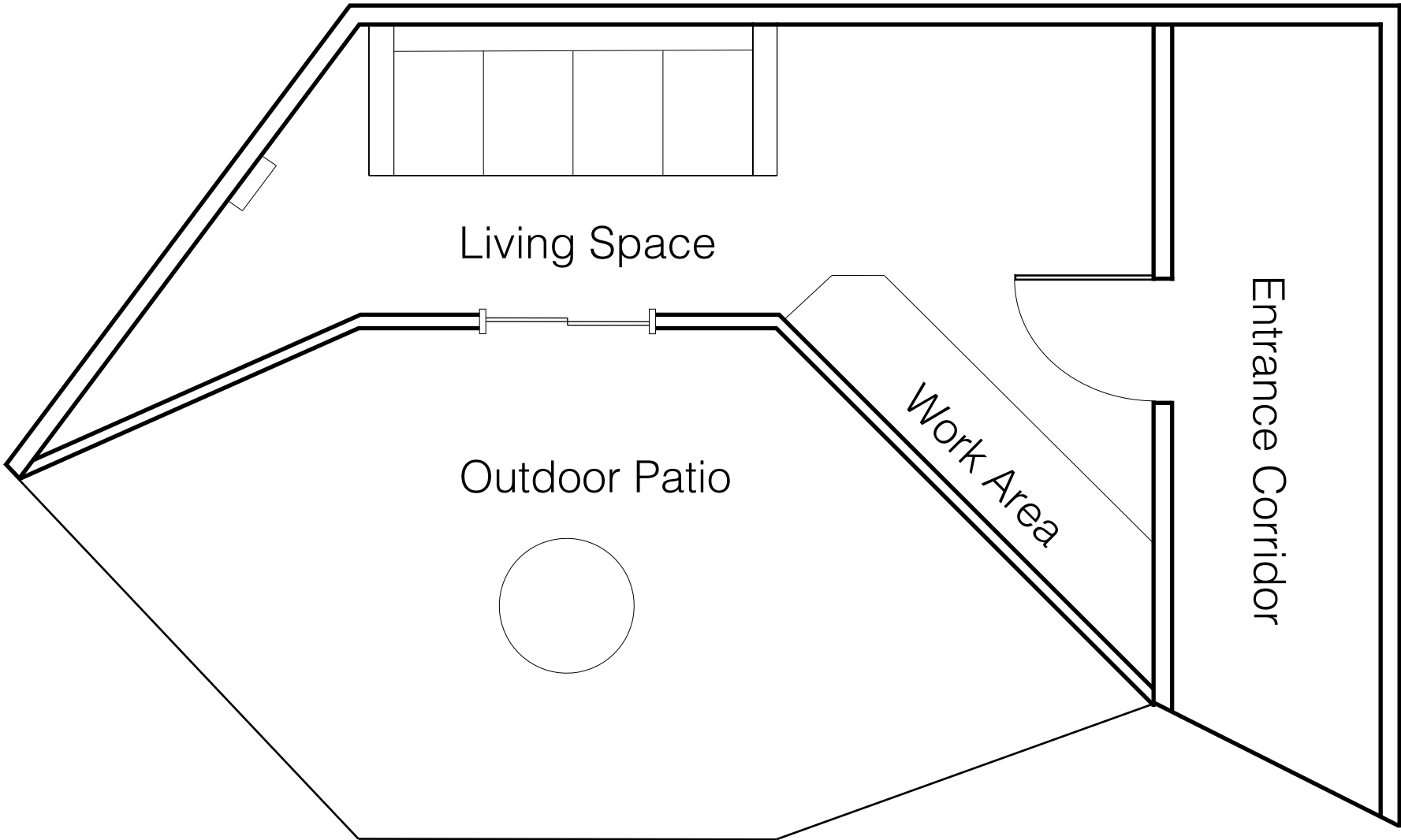

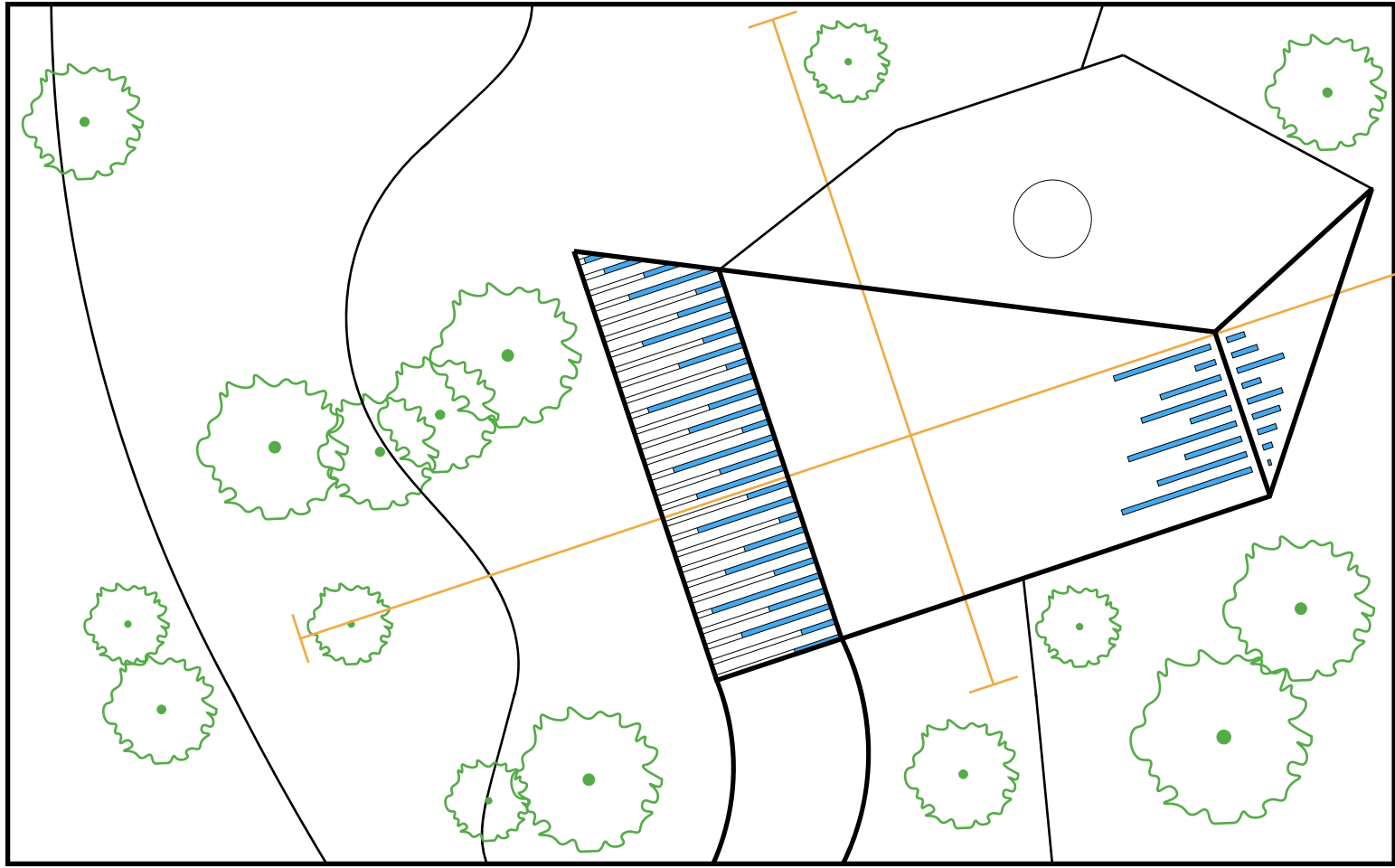
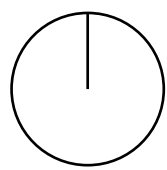


2ND FLOOR

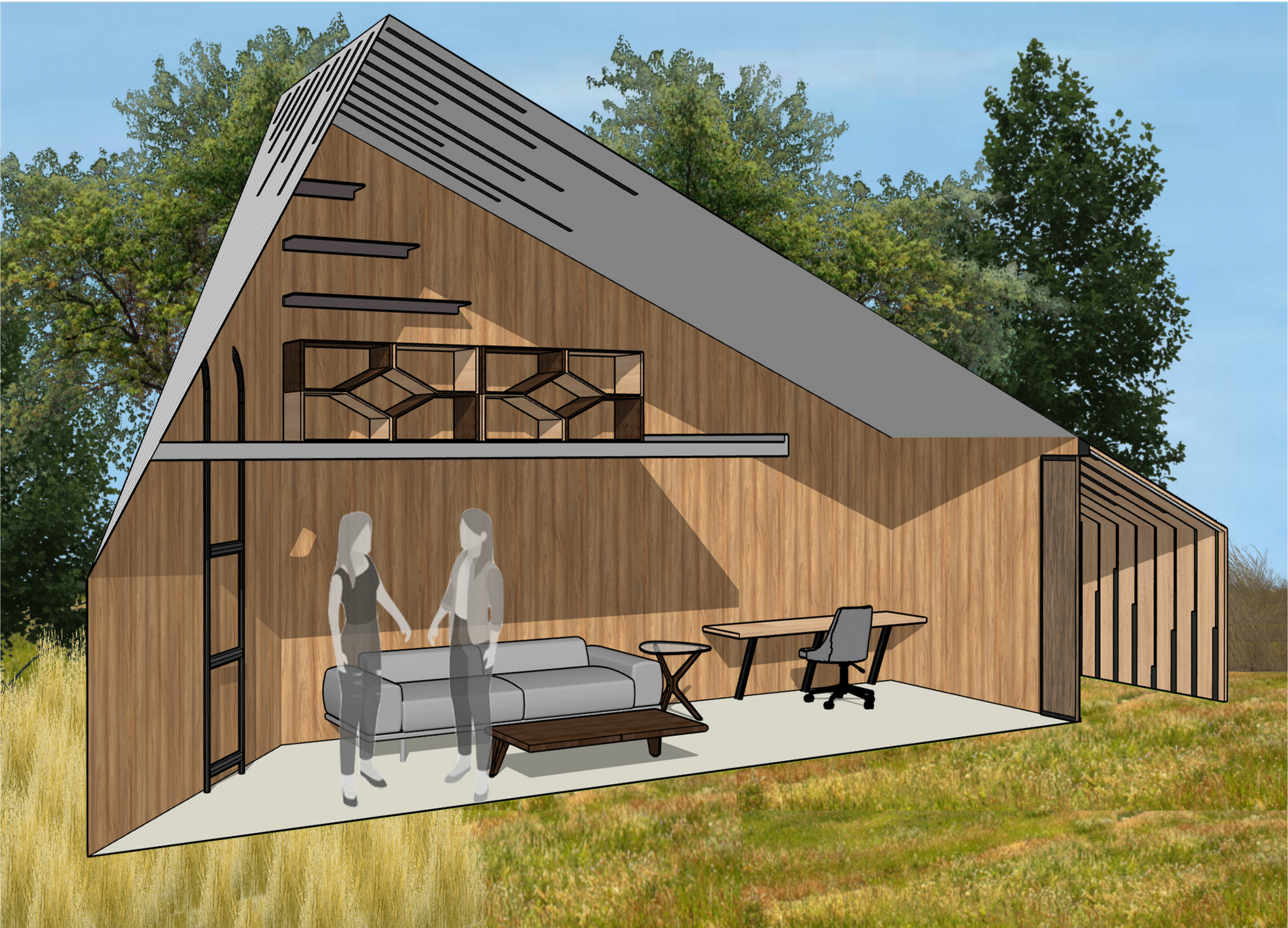
