



site plan

My aim is to take extremely simple geometry and to overlap it, intersect it, and play with its opacity to create a stunningly dynamic and complex sculptural piece. I use an industrial-modern minimalist architectural style because it allows the sculptural nature of the building to be at the forefront, and also carries with it undertones of the site's industrial history. I have included access to the river where kayaks can be launched and stored. The main lobby offers bike storage and a place to do laundry. The rooftop deck on the Southwest side of the building has the best possible view of Denver that the site can offer and is also a community gathering space. Lattice demonstrates that the micro housing lifestyle (375 square feet) can be truly luxurious and unique.
