During the summer this includes Seed2Seed, the teen summer leadership program, and Abejitas, our multigenerational summer program for children aged 3-10 and their caregivers to get curious about health and the natural world. The Intern will also work closely with our teen facilitators, former Seed2Seed students who help plan and lead summer programs with the Education team while receiving career development and personal mentorship.
