This form is intended to help you assess your current interests and skills, identify experience or skills that you would like to develop in an Internship, and as preparation for an interview with the Internship Host organization. Be sure you read all of the Internship information on the ENVS Website. To receive credit for an Internship, these steps must be followed:

1. Register for Internship credit, ENVS 3930. Note that you must indicate 1–3 credit hours for the Internship. Most Internships are 3 credits.
2. Find an internship.
3. Complete the Internship Agreement form together with the Internship Host; both of you must sign the Agreement form. And the ENVS Internship Faculty Sponsor must review and approve the Agreement.
