If they agree that (1) the topic is worth investigating; (2) the student has sufficient background in the topic; (3) the topic is not covered in sufficient depth in departmental courses; and (4) they share enough interest in the topic to sustain the project, then they may sign an independent study agreement. Faculty are under no compulsion to accept independent study students, but do so as their work load permits.
