The 12-credit Entrepreneurship Concentration will focus on building knowledge of the business context of engineering and technology. Progressing from concept validation to the development of a business plan, students will acquire the essential knowledge, understanding and skills to practice entrepreneurship in a start-up venture or within a larger corporation. All Entrepreneurship Concentration courses require a minimum grade of C.
