Instructional Mode Key

In Person: This class will be taught in person with all students attending each scheduled class.
Online: This class will be taught online and delivered asynchronously which means there are not scheduled days and times. Students can complete the coursework throughout the week when it is convenient for them.
Remote: This class will be taught synchronously as a remote section, which means classes will be held virtually during the days and times listed.
Hybrid - Remote & In Person: This class will be taught using a combination in person and remote instruction modes. This means that some coursework may be completed remotely at designated times, in addition to having an in person meeting pattern.
Hybrid - Remote & Online: This class will be taught using a combination of online and remote instruction modes. This means that while some coursework may be completed online at a student's own pace (asynchronous), the class will also meet remotely at designated days/times each week.
