






Biography

- “I wanted to have three things at the age of four: I wanted to be a writer, I wanted to win an Oscar and I wanted to be the drummer for *Kiss*.”





- **Favorite Activities** – Reading. walking around exploring new places. singing along to the radio, learning new things.


