Garage Outage – May 24 thru June 8

In order to complete certain work in and around the new building, the Euclid Parking Garage will be closed from May 24 thru June 8. Patrons are encouraged to park in the Folsom Parking Garage, as well as utilize all the on-street pay spots along Euclid Ave., 18th Street, and Wardenburg Drive.

18th Street One-Lane Outage – March 27 thru April 1

Repair work to a sanitary sewer line that crosses 18th Street takes place during the week of Spring Break. One lane will remain open during construction hours with flaggers present to direct traffic. Both lanes will be open in the evenings.



UCB Traditional Stonework

The application of CU Boulder's traditional Colorado sandstone is underway on the north and east faces of the building. The rules for the campus stonework patterns and colors are still carefully followed by campus planners and architects; and the handwork and craftsmanship required of the masons is essentially the same as it was nearly 100 years ago.

Limited Access to Service Area

The service area between the UMC and the CASE building remains closed to pedestrian traffic. Gates on both the north and south ends of the area are manned to allow only necessary drivers access to the lot. The three (3) ADA public parking spots remain available for use. The gates are open during non-construction hours.

Upcoming Outages

- Intersection of 18th Street & Euclid Ave – Utility work is still to come at this intersection.
- Sidewalk between CASE and VAC – there will be a late summer outage of this sidewalk, details to come.



Please continue to help us encourage pedestrians, bikers, and commuters to find alternate routes around the site to reduce congestion and maintain the safest environment possible throughout the project.
