Steel Work & Concrete Pours – Thru January 2017

The delivery of structural steel and steel erection is well underway. Construction trucks travel north on 18th Street, stopping along the east side of the site, then continue north to exit on Colorado Blvd. The first deck pour will take place on Monday which will bring some additional activity to the site.

Outages

Euclid Ave. will be reduced to one lane for one day next week for some necessary utility work in the street. There will be flaggers.

Intersection of Euclid Ave. & 18th Street

Although there is still work to be done, for the time being this intersection has been reopened. An ADA curb ramp will be added on the east side of 18th to reduce the length of the current accessible route. Please note that 18th Street is still a restricted pedestrian and transit zone only, and all thru traffic should use alternate routes to avoid extra congestion and delays.
