Beginning next week, please expect an increased amount of activity around the site and through the intersection at 18th Street and Euclid Avenue as steel work begins. **As always, feel free to contact Stephen Graziano with any questions or concerns.**

Steel Delivery & Work – Now thru January 2017

The delivery of structural steel and steel erection has started. Delivery trucks will be traveling north on 18th Street, stopping along the east side of the site, then continuing north to exit on Colorado Blvd. We are targeting early morning deliveries

starting at 6:00 am. There will be flaggers, but we ask that everyone use extra caution while travelling around the site during this time. The rolling crane is in place and will operate within the confines of the site fencing and be folded up at night.

Intersection of Euclid Ave. & 18th Street – Ongoing

Although there is still work to be done, for the time being this intersection has been reopened. The construction fence will be adjusted along 18th Street to accommodate steel delivery, and the intersection will be well-marked. The gates have been removed for now, but 18th Street is still a restricted pedestrian and transit zone only, and all thru traffic should use alternate routes to avoid extra congestion and delays.



Garage closed until January 2017
