Podcast: Coffeebreak French

Coffeebreak French is a Podcast made up of 5 seasons that correspond to different levels of French with 1 being beginners and 5 being the most advanced. The seasons feature 40 free lessons that are about 20-30 minutes each. The episodes are engaging and incredibly useful. The team includes language teachers, native speakers, and host learners. Additionally, the courses have been carefully written by experienced educators. There is an option to take this further and sign up to receive video materials, lesson notes, and bonus audio content.
