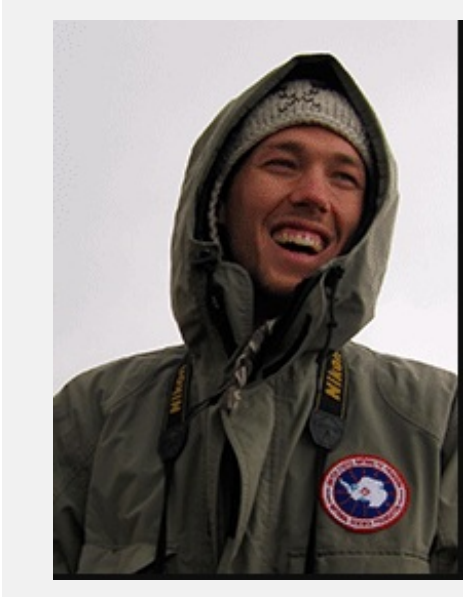

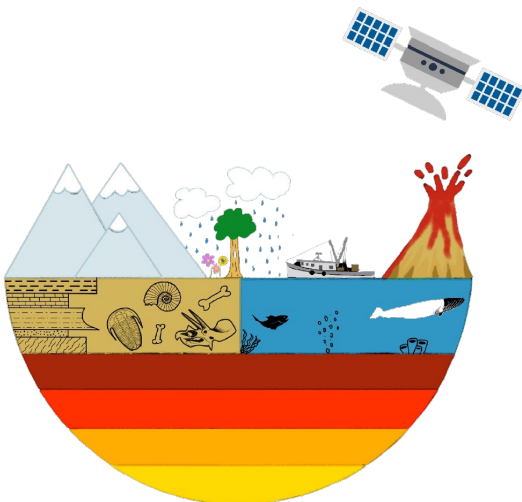
Colloquium and Happenings


