Dissertation Completion Fellowship

Outstanding PhD candidates can apply for full financial support for one academic semester (Fall 2026 or Spring 2027) to complete their dissertations. The fellowship includes a monthly stipend equivalent to a 50% GPTI salary, tuition for up to five dissertation hours, mandatory fees, and Gold health insurance coverage. Applicants must advance to D status by the end of Spring 2026 and cannot hold other employment during the fellowship period. Apply by **November 14th, 2025!**

ASEN 5226: Medicine in Space and Surface Environments

The course focuses on medical considerations for a human mission to the Moon or Mars. There is a field component where we do simulated spacewalks to give hands-on practice for spaceflight operations and space medicine. The field simulation will occur over Spring Break at the Mars Desert Research Station in Spring 2026. Class enrollment is limited, so students are asked to apply using the link below. mathematics. Eligible applicants include college seniors, gap year students, and first-year graduate students. The application deadline is **October 31, 2025**.

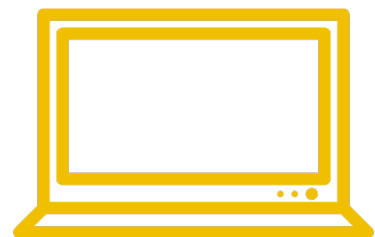
