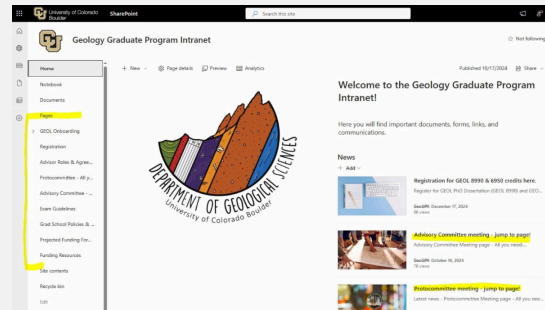

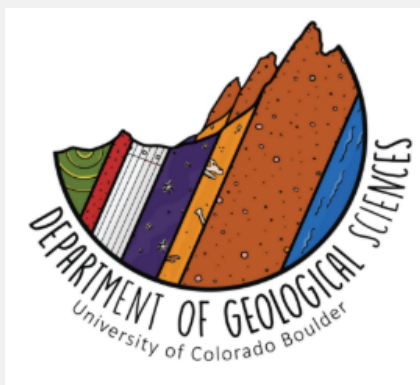

Fiske Planetarium Facilitator Opportunity

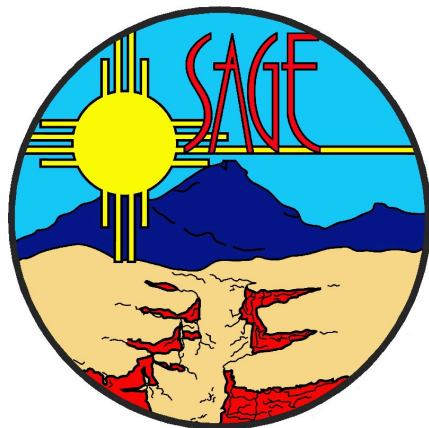
