
# This is the page you get when clicking on the class name on the previous page






This is what Canvas looks like. Your new Canvas page will be under 'Unpublished classes' since you haven't published it yet.




When I click on the course name it takes me to the Canvas page Now you can start editing and adding content to your Canvas page




### Go to 'Announcements' to add a welcoming announcement to the class




### Here is an example of a Welcoming announcement to the class
