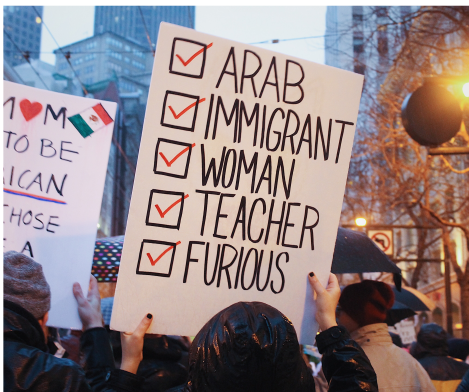


Racism In American Culture
