

Honors Residential Academic Program **2019-2020 Contract**

Congratulations CU Boulder Honors Student!

- We are delighted that you have chosen the Honors Residential Academic Program (Honors RAP) as part of your CU Boulder experience for the 2019-2020 academic year.
 - You must accept the terms of the Honors RAP contract in order to live in Smith Hall, register for an Honors RAP course and otherwise participate in Honors RAP programs.
 - The Honors RAP contract is not a housing contract.
 - Housing & Dining Services/Occupancy Management notifies students of their room assignments in Smith Hall. *
- 1) I understand that if I choose not to agree to this contract, I will lose my housing assignment in Smith Hall and Housing will place me in another residence.
 - 2) I agree to pay the 2019-20 Honors RAP fee of **\$850**. I understand that the fee is not refundable and will be added to my student bill in the fall.
 - 3) As a first-year student, I agree to participate in the Honors RAP by enrolling in one 3-credit hour Honors RAP course **each semester**, fall 2019 and spring 2020.
 - 4) I agree to participate in the Honors RAP by making a diligent effort to attend Honors RAP co-curricular activities and flock-led events, including weekday evening small group activities and all-hall Honors RAP events.
 - 5) I understand that if I choose not to take Honors RAP classes, I may be asked to leave the program and my residence, and will not receive a refund of the program fee.
 - 6) I understand that if I violate the standards of behavior and civility set by the Office of Housing & Dining Services of the University of Colorado Boulder, I may be required to leave the Honors RAP program and my residence, and will not receive a refund of the program fee.
 - 7) I understand that if I voluntarily leave the Honors RAP for any reasons other than withdrawal from the University itself, I will not receive a refund of the program fee.
 - 8) I understand that I assume full responsibility for all risk or injury or loss which may result from my participation in the Honors RAP activities and I agree to hold harmless the Regents of the University of Colorado, their officers, agents, employees, the Honors Program staff and student leaders from any and all claims and demands whatsoever which I, or my representatives, may have by reason of any accident, illness, injury to or death of any person or persons, or damage to or loss or destruction of any property arising or resulting directly or indirectly from participation in the Honors RAP .
 - 9) I hereby give my permission to the Office of Housing & Dining Services personnel to discuss my student conduct cases, decisions, and related concerns with the Director of the Honors RAP.
 - 10) I give the Honors RAP my permission to use photographs taken of me while participating in Honors RAP classes or activities for purposes of public relations. These photographs may appear on the program's website, brochures, or presentations.
 - 11) I understand that I must get permission from the Director of the Honors RAP for an exception to this agreement.
