## Petition to create an independent second area of emphasis

Humanities majors may, in consultation with the Humanities Program's Director of Undergraduate Studies, petition to create a unique area of emphasis for the second area, which requires 12 hours of upper- or lower-division coursework. Students should select four 3-credit-hour courses that fit a particular theme of the student's choosing. Students will then present a rationale for the significance of the proposed area of emphasis for the the student's studies and future career path. This rationale should include 1) a description of the theme and its significance and 2) a description of the unity and applicability of the proposed courses to the theme.

Courses may be selected from any University of Colorado course offerings. Permission may be granted for courses taken elsewhere if the rationale is strong enough.
