CU Boulder has once again demonstrated its global reach, <u>earning the No. 2 spot on the Peace Corps' 2025 list of top volunteer-producing colleges and universities</u>. With 39 alumni currently serving in 28 countries, Buffs continue to make a difference around the world—including IAFS alumna Julia Leone, who recently served as a health volunteer in Madagascar.

Reflecting on the tools she gained while at CU, Julia shared, "For me, my CU experience was largely marked by community, mentorship and learning how to navigate difficult and unexpected obstacles. Being able to come up with creative and collaborative solutions to big and small problems, especially across cultural and language divides, is vital to Peace Corps service."
