- The closest parking lot to Limelight Hotel is the [Grandview Parking Garage](#). Free CU parking is available on **levels 3 and above** (levels B1-2 are for Limelight Hotel guests)

- Guests and graduates should enter through the **Conference Entrance** at the Limelight Hotel (located to the north of the main hotel entrance on 13<sup>th</sup> St.).
  - *As there will be at least two hours between the main campus and IAFS ceremonies, we encourage you and your guests to grab lunch, coffee, or celebrate on the Hill or Pearl Street rather than waiting at the hotel.*
- **Guest seating** at the Limelight Flatirons Ballroom will open at **12:00pm**. **Guests** should proceed directly to **Flatirons Ballroom** to find seating.
- **Graduates** should plan to arrive between **12:00–12:45pm** (no later than 12:50pm). **Graduates** will check in and wait in **Meadows Ballroom** before the ceremony.
  - Graduates who arrive **after** the ceremony starts may be held at the back of the ballroom until a natural break when they can be seated with the other graduates.
