Why take IAFS 4930?

- **Reflect and connect** your internship experience to your IAFS studies
- **Asynchronous** course that easily fits into your schedule
- **Fulfills IAFS Off-Campus Experience (OCE)** requirement
- Appears on your **academic transcript** — a boost for jobs and grad school

About the IAFS Internship Program

- Open to **junior** and **senior** IAFS majors
- Earn **3 credits** while completing a minimum of **120 hours** of internship work
- Must be **enrolled in IAFS 4930** during the same semester as the internship
- Internships must have **clear international content**
- **Pre-approved internship list** available online

How it Works



1. **Find** an internship.
2. **Complete** the application.
3. **Meet** with Internship Director for internship approval.
4. **Submit** your internship agreement.
