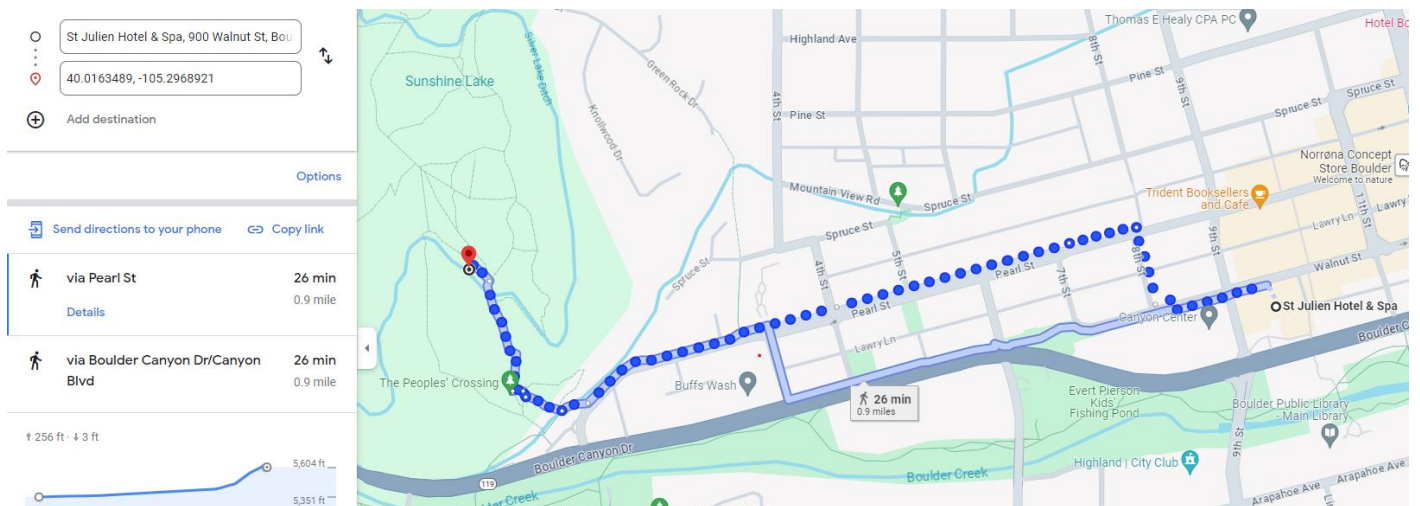


WEDNESDAY HIKE
