

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## PREFACE

This publication lists works written as a result of the authors' collaboration with the Institute of Arctic and Alpine Research (INSTAAR), either as full members or as colleagues and associates. It does not represent a complete list of an individual author's publications, since nearly everyone was associated at least in part with another institution during the period 1968-1985. The list includes all publications collected (for 1968-1974) in our previously prepared but not formally published list (1975).

I feel that this is a valuable, and I hope complete, compilation of the approximately 900 publications to have come out of INSTAAR during the 17-year period. I hope that it will have a wide use for workers who wish to draw on INSTAAR's legacy of research in arctic and alpine environments worldwide, especially in the Colorado Rocky Mountains, Alaska, and the Canadian Arctic, and in related paleoenvironments.

References are listed by year and then alphabetically by first author. The index lists all authors, followed by year and then by the number of the publication within the year.

Unfortunately, INSTAAR does not have the facilities to distribute copies of the listed publications as reprints, although our own publications, the Occasional Paper series and the quarterly journal Arctic and Alpine Research, are available for sale. Individual requests for reprints will be forwarded to present and former INSTAAR employees and associates.

The publications listed here were produced during the period that INSTAAR was directed by my predecessors, Jack D. Ives and Patrick J. Webber; they are to be congratulated for a productive enterprise.
