 - 3. Intersectional network of students envisioning environmental and social transformation received 5 votes
 - 4. Inclusivity, nonviolence, and social justice training 5 votes
 - 5. Keep invst as an acronym that doesn't stand for anything

 - E. Proposed process for restarting this name conversation
 - 1. Initial plan: review the names handed out and reviewed sit with them for the next month.

 - (a) Vote on your top 3 and then put another option and type in what people want
 - (2) Deadline for coming up with a new one once the whole list is compiled then make a survey monkey
 - b) Action Steps: Plan pick a date to send names in by, compile them into a survey, we vote and pick our top 5, send the top 5 to alumni

- c) Kayleigh is spearheading kayleigh is going to send out a google survey asking for new ideas for a name, going to make a deadline and compile, then she will make a survey monkey people will vote on the top 5, she will take the top 5 of all of them and send them to sabrina to send to alumni
