


International Student Statistics: Fall 2015

A total of 2646 Undergraduate, Master's, and PhD international students from 100 countries attended the University of Colorado Boulder in the fall 2015 semester. Of those 2646 students, 29 students are non-degree seeking and 2617 are degree seeking students. There are currently 1782 male and 864 female international students.






