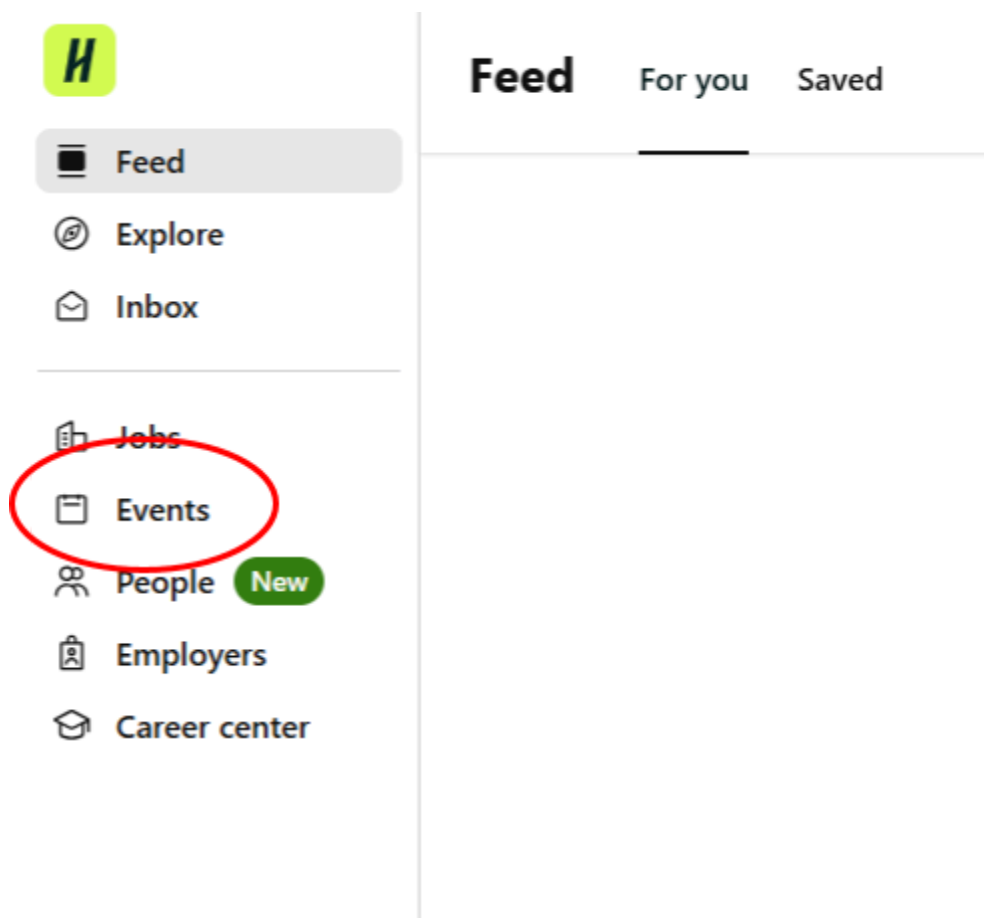


FINDING EMPLOYERS IN CAREER FAIRS IN HANDSHAKE THAT WILL SUPPORT OPT/CPT AND/OR SPONSOR A WORK VISA

First, log in to your student or alum Handshake account. You'll be directed to the 'Feed', similar to a Facebook feed. On the left side of the screen you'll see a menu of options, as shown below. You'll click on 'Events'.



This will take you to a list of events and fairs, as shown in the image below. You'll search for and click on the career fair from the list of events that you are interested in attending. The example career fair shown in the following images is from a past fair.

DEFINITIONS

US work authorization is required: If this is written, this means that an employer is not accepting OPT/CPT candidates, NOR are they sponsoring any work visas. In this case, you must be a US citizen for this employer. See example below.

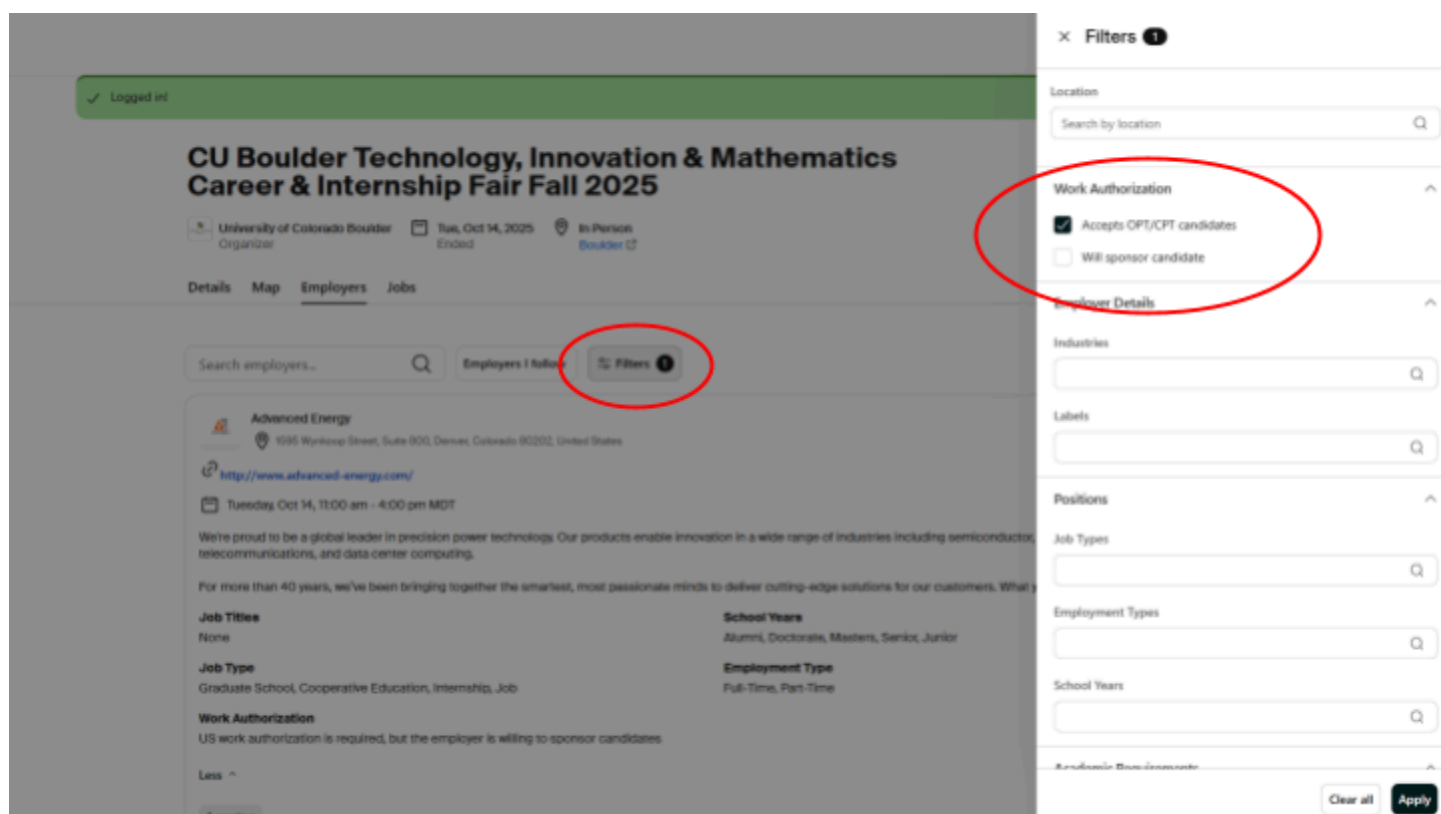

To make your search even easier, you can filter the employer list based on which employers accept OPT/CPT and/or sponsor work visas. **PLEASE NOTE:** if you select both options to filter together, you will only see employers with the designation ' US work authorization required, but the employer is willing to sponsor candidates'. Again, this does mean they accept OPT/CPT. You can filter employers specifically saying they accept OPT/CPT candidates by only using the CPT/OPT filter.
