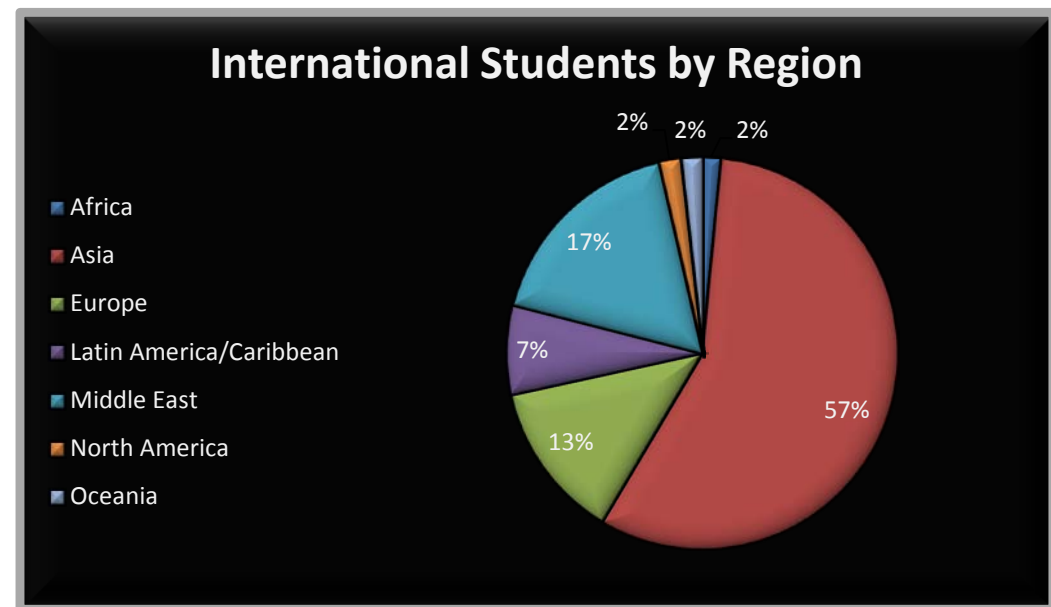

A total of 1879 International Students (Undergraduate, Masters & PhD) from 91 countries attended the University of Colorado Boulder in the Fall semester of 2013.

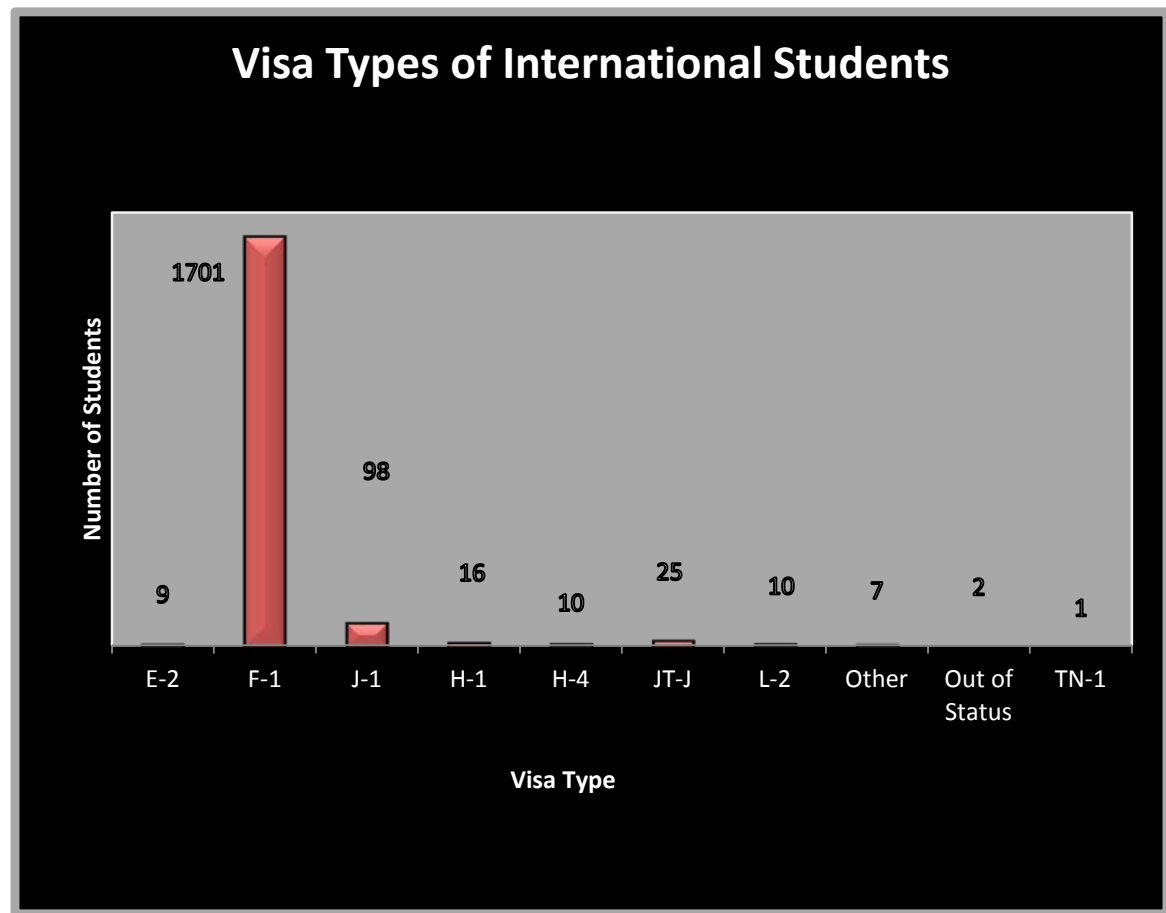
