

Statistical Summary of International Student Enrollment

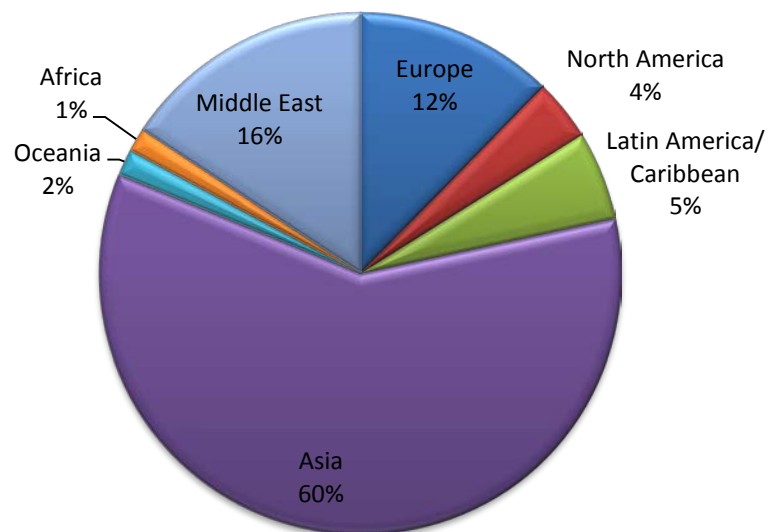
Fall 2012

A total of 1,674 international students from 83 different countries were enrolled at the University of Colorado at Boulder for the Fall 2012 semester. Of those students, 1,643 are degree-seeking, while 31 are Science Without Borders (non-degree seeking) students. The following is a statistical summary of international student enrollment.

1) Where CU-Boulder international students come from, by region:

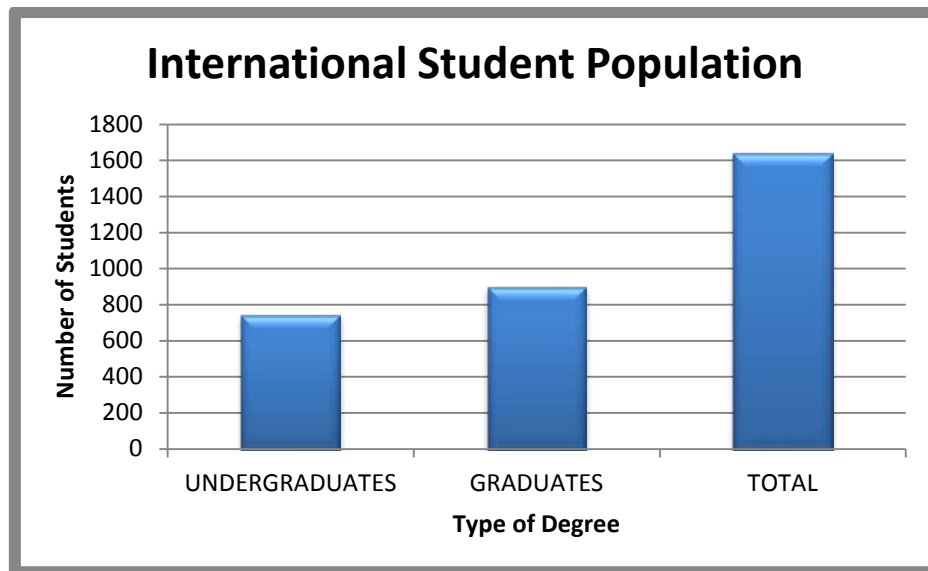

International Student Population by Region



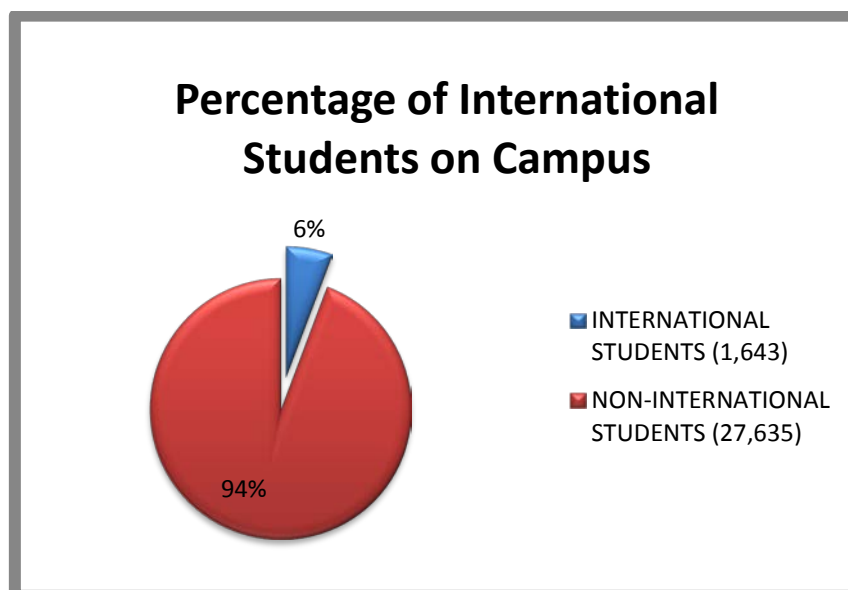

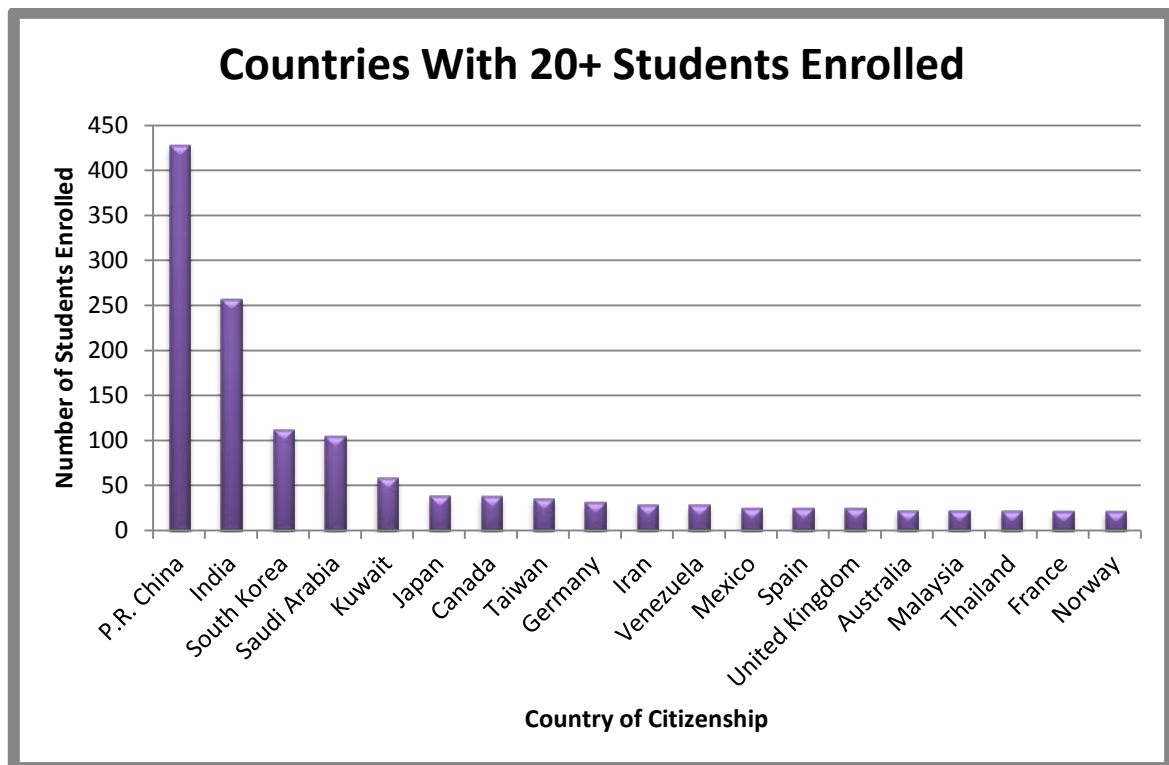

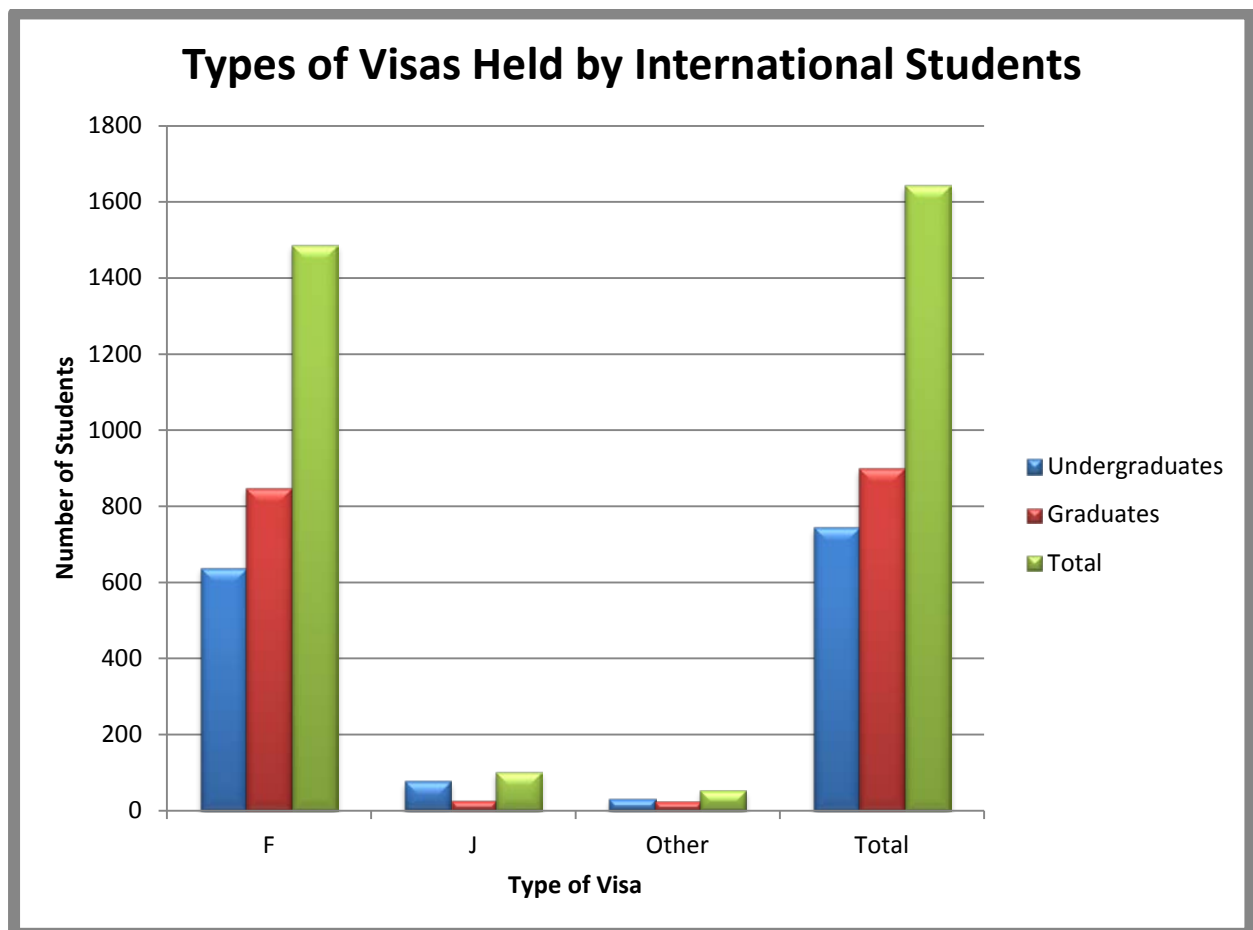

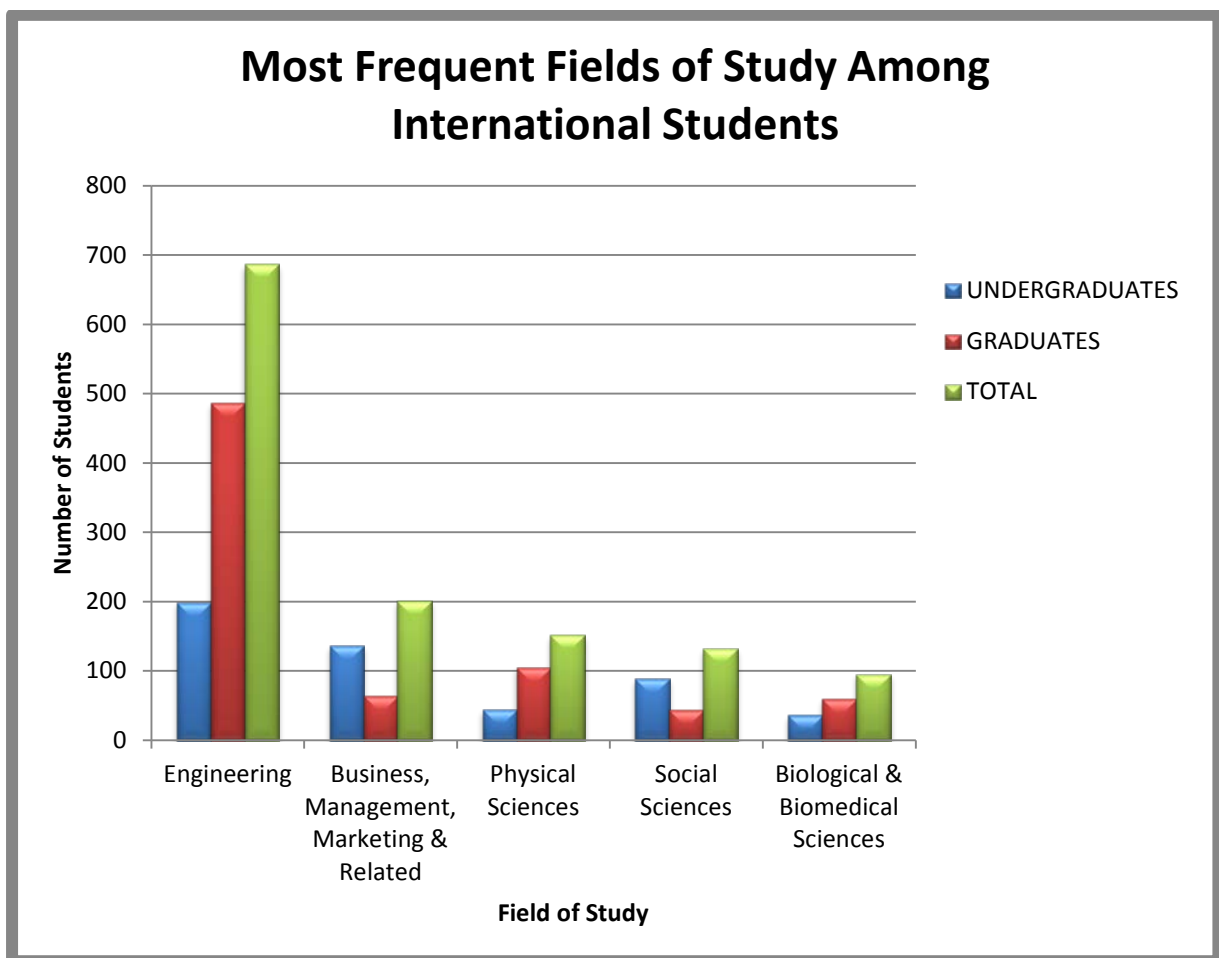

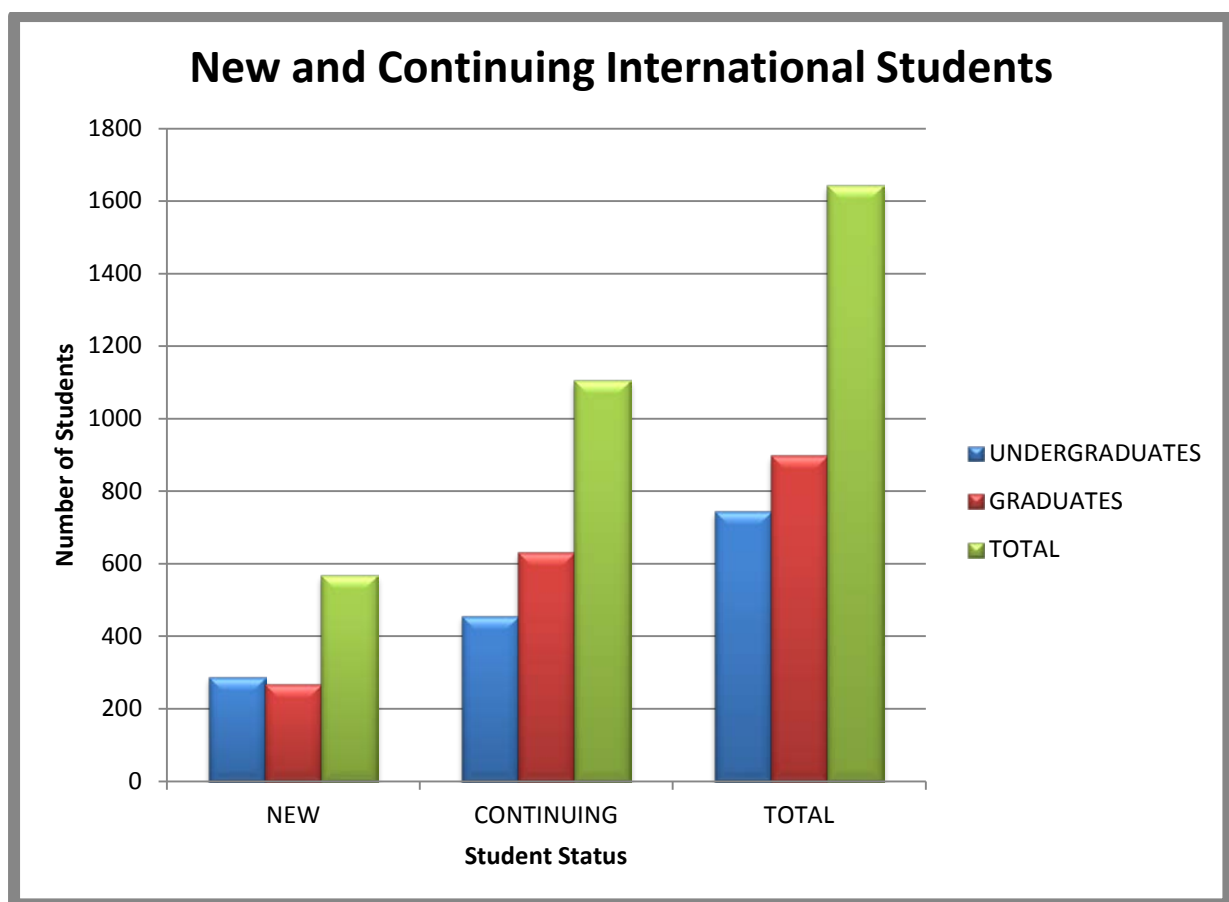

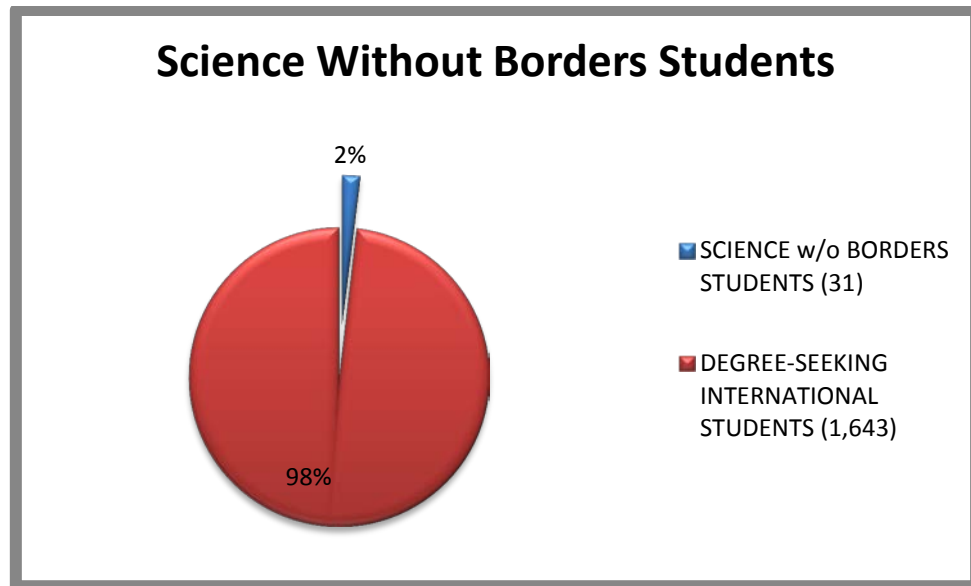
