Basic Requirements:

- Full-Time student at a 4-year college for the Spring 2018 semester
- Commit 10 hours per week
- Involved in at least one on-campus organization

The Campus Ambassador Program teaches students to:

- Organize both private and public events on campus and in your college community
- Mobilize, manage, and motivate volunteers from a variety of organizations for a worthwhile cause
- Educate yourself and others on the science behind bone marrow and stem cell donation
- Advertise your campus drives with personalized marketing materials unique to your school
- Advocate by publicly presenting your program in front of groups both large and small - be they peers or professors
- Fundraise and create your own program budget based on what you're able to bring in
- Follow up with fellow students, organizations, and faculty to build ongoing relationships

Specific responsibilities include:

- Weekly check-ins with a Program Manager
- Swabbing students into the Gift of Life Registry
- Fundraising
- Bi-monthly webinars designed for continuing education throughout the semester
