





Our Services




Courses taught:

Accomplishments

- Initiated a major collection management project.
- Relocated 14,000 journal volumes offsite to create future student study space.
- Placed 200+ books on reserve to support student learning and faculty teaching.
- Purchased a substantial number of faculty-authored works to enhance our Faculty Publications collection.
- Curated themed book displays by month, including women's history, labor law, and PRIDE month.
- Taught a legal research session during Wolf Week.
- Hosted student trainings, called Wise Up Workshops, on dockets, litigation analytics, and free and low-cost resources.
- Surveyed students and faculty about library services and spaces.
- Ran fun and welcoming activities like the Halloween costume contest and Woof and Wellness therapy dogs.
