Classes noted with an asterisk (\*) indicate that it is not part of bidding. There will be a special signup via the listserv for more details. Students who miss the signup deadline must wait to enroll starting in mid-November after bidding ends. The course capacity for bidding is noted on the BID SPOTS (BID SP) column.

2L and 3L students can take up to 18 credits a semester. Wintersession courses are part of spring tuition. Students can take one wintersession course. Those who choose to do that can take up to 20 total credits as the wintersession courses are done prior to the beginning of spring term. Students cannot take classes which overlap in times and/or have the same start/end times. M=Monday, T=Tuesday, W=Wednesday, TH=Thursday, F=Friday

Note: All clinics are not part of bidding and had a special registration form administered through the Clinic Office **last spring**. It is too late to add a clinic for spring 2025 if you did not sign up through the clinic registration process last spring. If the clinic is year-long, students receive credits for both fall and spring terms. For example, if it is noted here as four credits for fall term and four credits for spring term, students receive eight total credits for the year. If it is noted here as three credits for fall term and three credits for spring term, students receive six credits for the year. Clinics are not part of the 14-credit cap. They **do** count towards the experiential learning graduation requirement.
