Application Checklist and Instructions

1. **LL.M. application.** Please apply electronically at www.lsac.org (The Law School Admission Council).
2. **Application fee.** Please pay the non-refundable \$65.00 application fee when you apply electronically.
3. **Required personal essay.** The purpose of the Colorado Law LL.M. degree is to allow law graduates to engage deeply in research, scholarship, and substantive law, and to interact extensively with experts in their field of study. For the LL.M. track to which you are applying, describe what you view as the most important issues facing the legal community.
Your essay should be typed, double-spaced and not exceed 1,000 words.
4. **Resume or CV.** Please show volunteer activities as well as work experience.
5. **Two letters of recommendation.** Recommendations should be submitted directly to LSAC. At least one of the recommendation letters needs to be from a law school professor.
6. **Transcripts.** Please have an original transcript from each college or university attended sent directly to LSAC. If you are selected to matriculate at Colorado Law, you must provide two original transcripts from each college and university attended. If you previously attended CU-Boulder, only one original transcript is needed.
7. **Instructions for International Students Only:**
To be eligible for the Colorado Law LL.M. programs, a student must have received a degree which would allow them to practice law in the country from which the degree is received. Any applicant who has earned a degree outside the United States needs to have the degree verified. If the applicant has not already done this using a commercial service, he may use the services of the LSAC.
Applicants must also submit with their application a certified translation of any transcripts that are not in English.
Please go to www.colorado.edu/oie/iss for additional information regarding finances and applying for a visa. (Note: Students who have established permanent residency in the United States and have alien registration numbers are not considered foreign students.)
An acceptable TOEFL score is required for any applicant for whom English is not their first language.
8. **Request for In-State Tuition.** Complete the In-State Tuition Classification Application at www.colorado.edu/law/admissions/application-and-catalog if you believe you are eligible to be classified as a resident for tuition purposes.
9. Once your application is complete and ready for review by the Admissions Committee, we will send you notification by email. Please configure your email account to accept email from addresses ending in "colorado.edu."
The program directors may request an interview, either in person or by telephone, as part of the application review process. You will be contacted to arrange an interview, if necessary.
