1. Completed application. Please send your completed application, along with a check or money order for \$65, made out to the *University of Colorado*, for our non-refundable application fee, to the following address:

2. Required personal essay. The essay should be no longer than 500 words, typed, and double-spaced. Please submit an essay, in your own words, on the topic above.

3. Your resume or CV. Please show volunteer activities as well as paid work experience.

4. Two letters of recommendation. At least one of the letters should be from a law school professor. A copy of the Evaluation of Applicant form must accompany the letters. This form is available on our website (<http://lawweb.colorado.edu/apps/catalog>).

5. Transcripts. Submit transcripts for all previous college, university, and law school work. Please also submit a letter of good standing from the dean of your current law school. If you are applying to visit, please also include a letter granting permission from your home school for you to visit at Colorado Law. Transfer applicants should include their class rank information.

6. CAS report. Submit a copy of the first page of your CAS report. Your law school should be able to provide you with a copy.

7. If you believe you qualify for in-state tuition status in Colorado, also complete the **Request for In-state Tuition Classification** form, which is available on our website at <http://lawweb.colorado.edu/apps/catalog>.
