REM=Remote course content will be delivered synchronously at scheduled days and times in any of the following ways: Zoom, lecture capture or Canvas. NOTE that on *this* schedule, remote classes are listed as REM, but will be listed as HY on your schedule in Buff Portal. We know this is the case. The HY status allows the system to assign a room number to a class so on-campus students may have a physical space to participate in class meetings, if needed. Room numbers will be added to this schedule closer to the start of the term.

HY=(Hybrid In Person/Online and/or In Person/Remote)Taught using a combination of in-person (same meeting pattern(s) for all enrolled students) and online, remote or a combination of instruction modes.

CAP=Shows room capacity allowed with social distancing

Courses with prereqs of those using pass/grading are noted as are any courses with shorter meeting patterns (i.e. 7 week courses).

Note: All clinics had a special registration form administered through the Clinic Office. If the clinic is year-long, students receive credits for both fall and spring terms. For example, if it is noted here as four credits for fall term **and** four credits for spring term, students receive eight total credits for the year.

2L and 3L students can take up to 18 credits a semester. Fallsession courses are part of fall tuition. Students can take one fallsession course. Those who choose to do that can then take up to 19 total credits as the fallsession courses are done prior to the beginning of fall term. Students cannot take classes which overlap in times and/or have the same start/end times.
