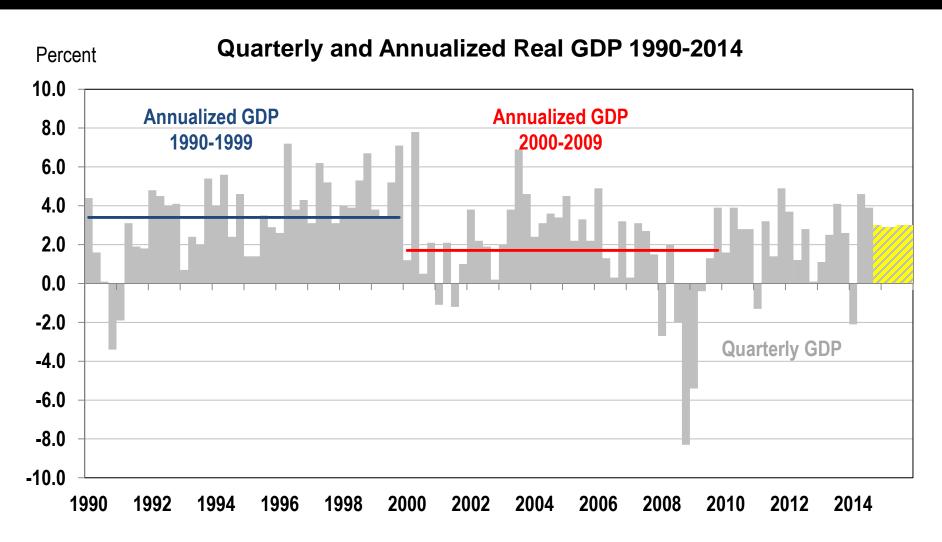


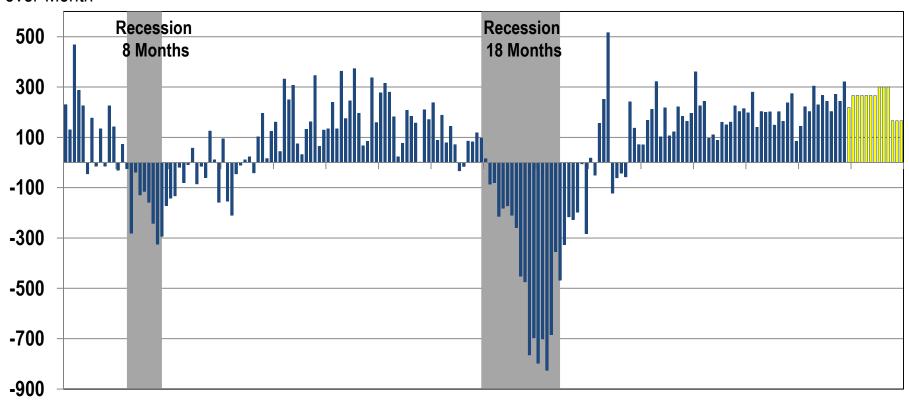
Real GDP Growth

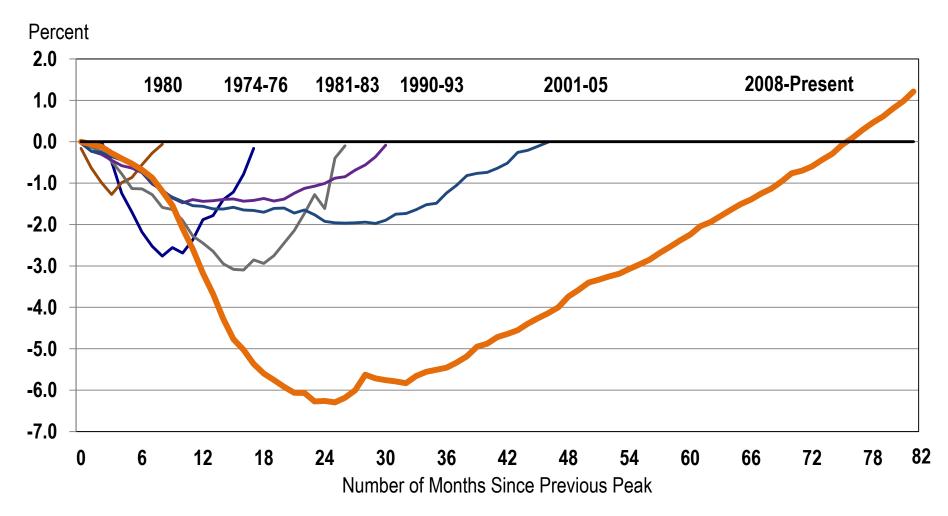

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National Employment Months to Recovery

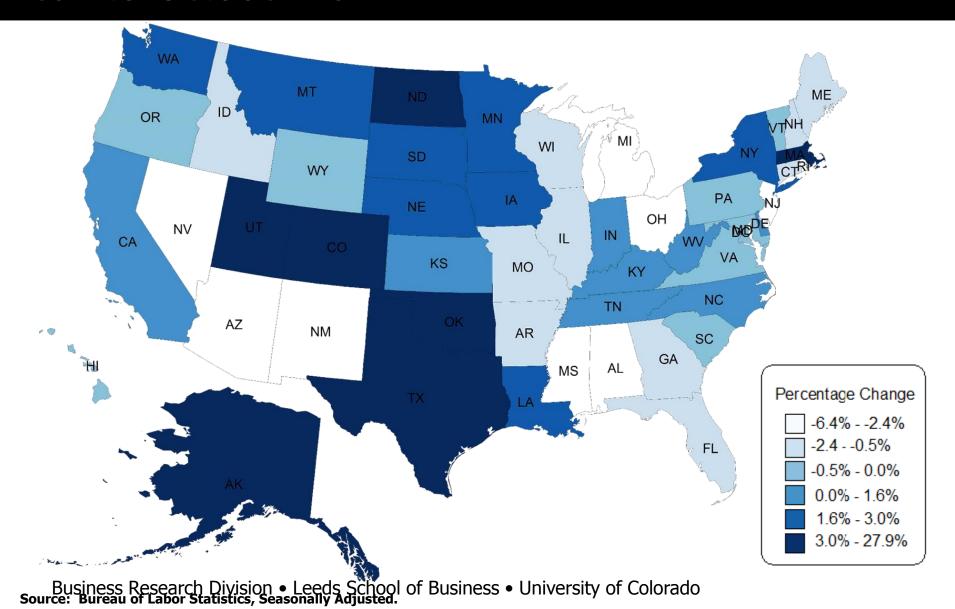

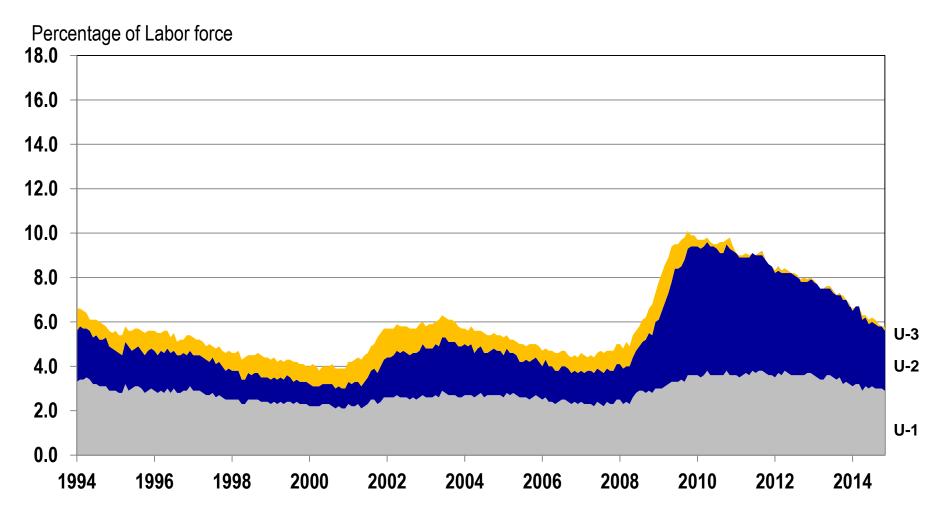
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National Employment Growth

Peak-to-October 2014



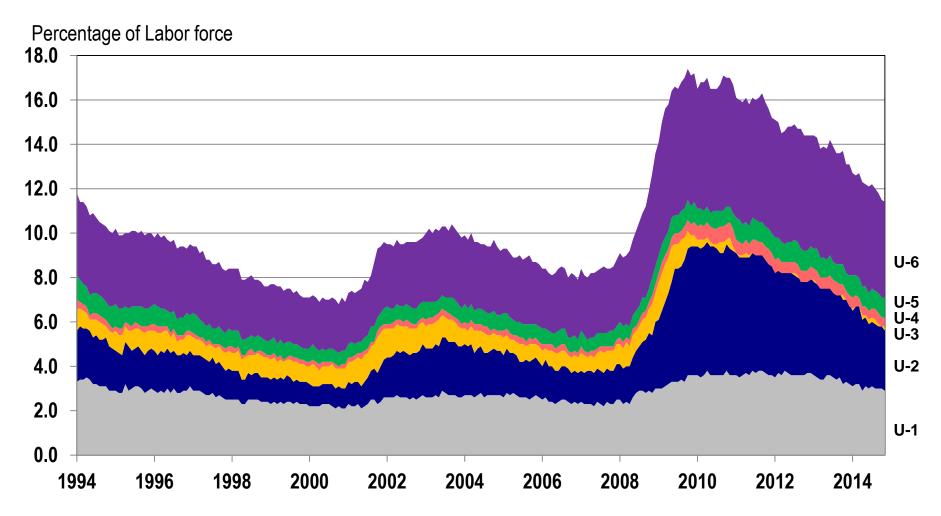
National Unemployment

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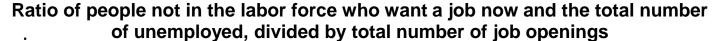

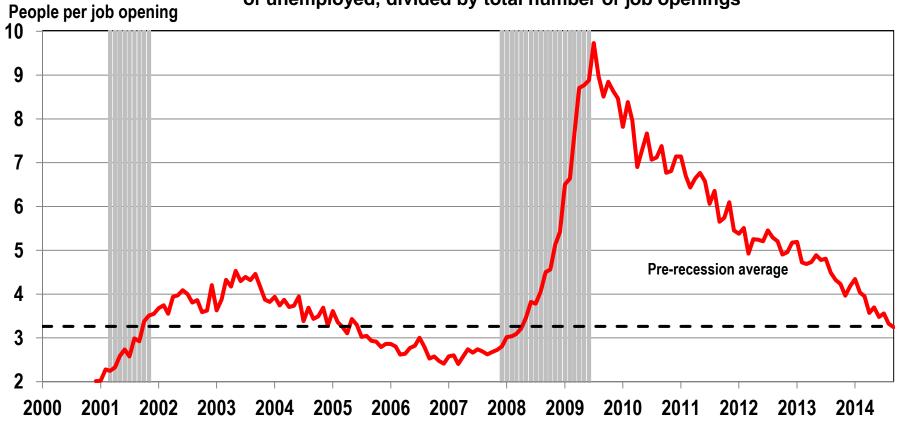

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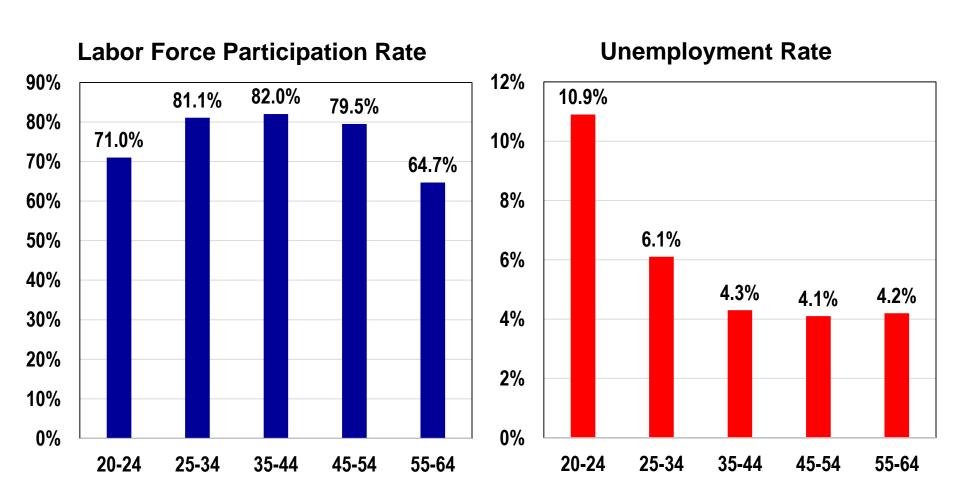
Labor Slack Number of Available People Per Job Opening

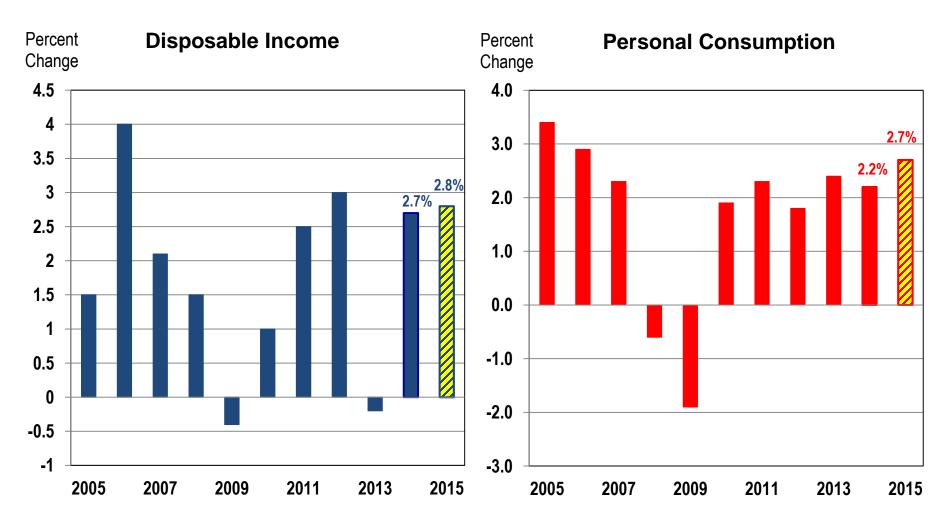
Labor Force and Unemployment Rate National, by Age Cohort, November 2014

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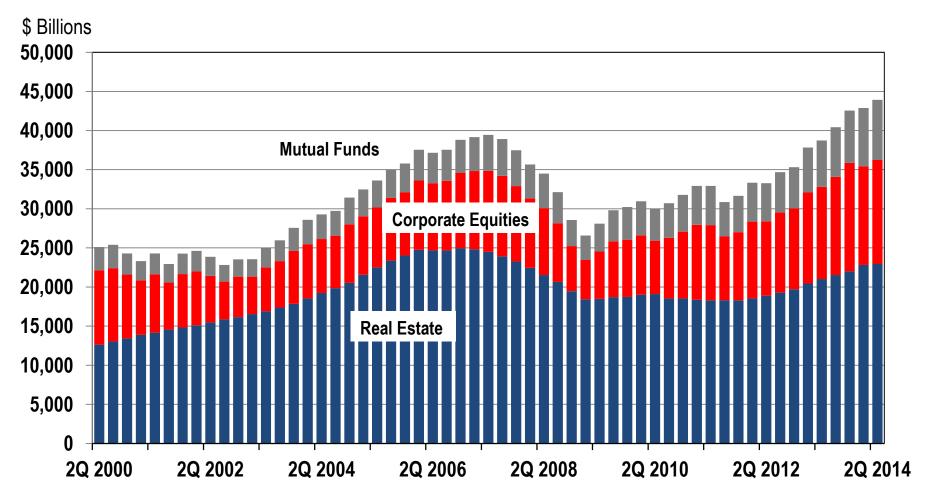

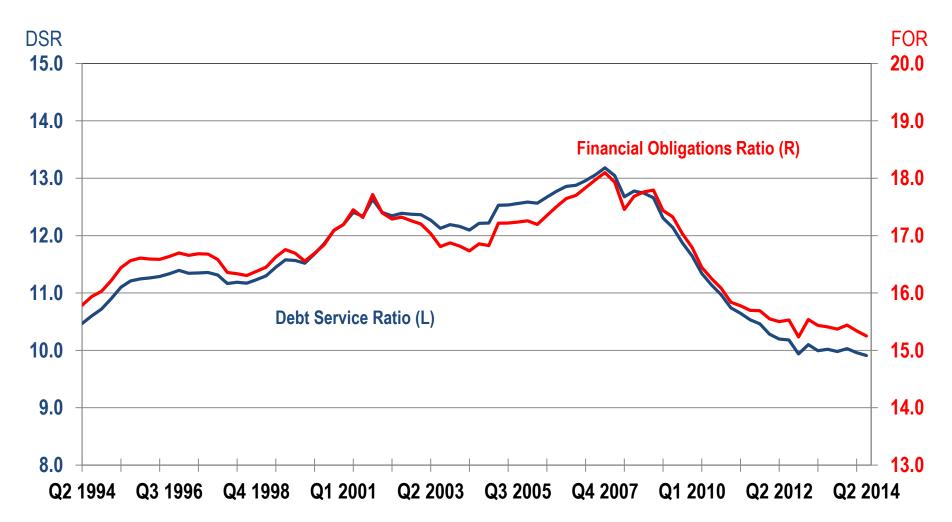

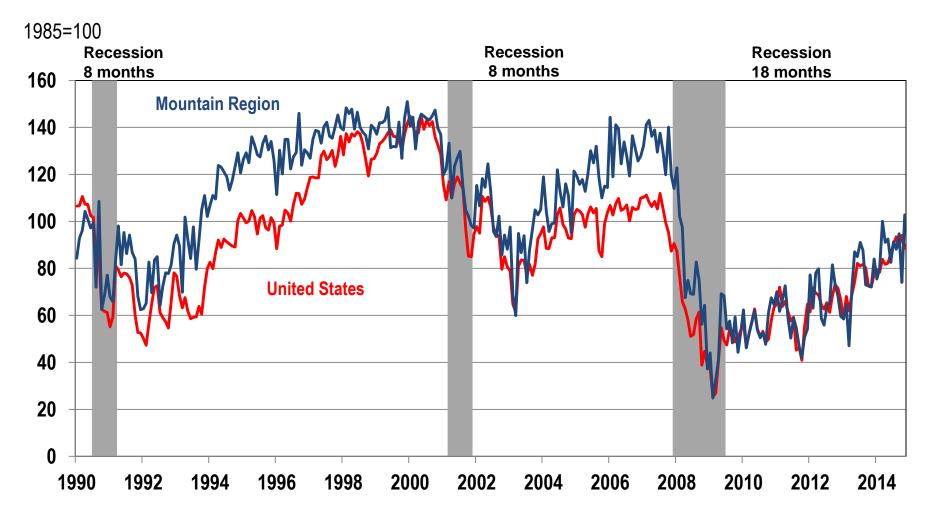
Household Debt Burden Percent of Disposable Income

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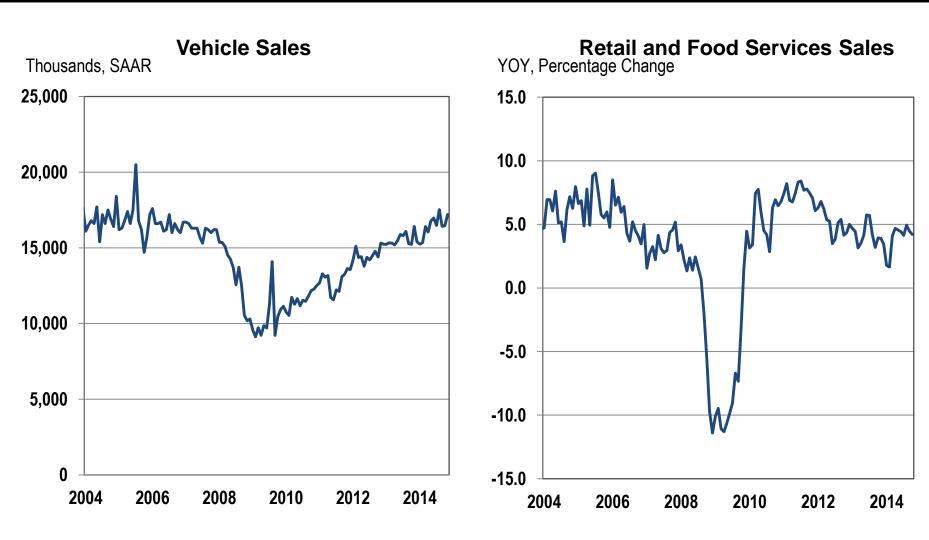

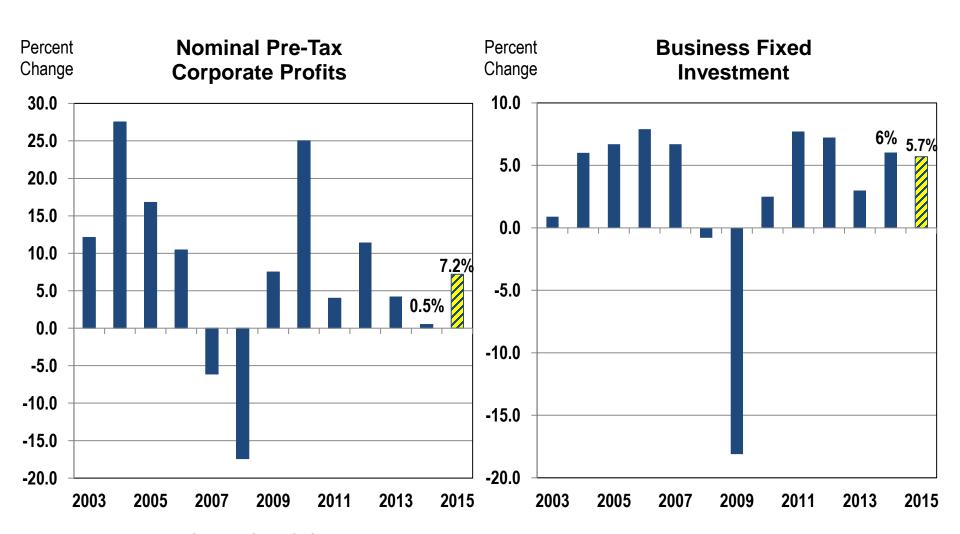
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Vehicle Sales and Retail Sales

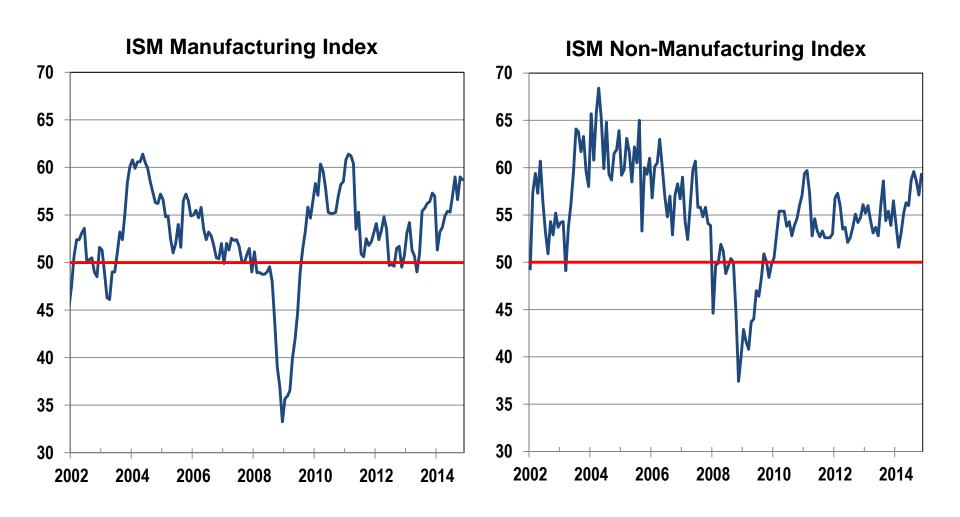
Nominal Corporate Profits and U.S. Business Fixed Investment

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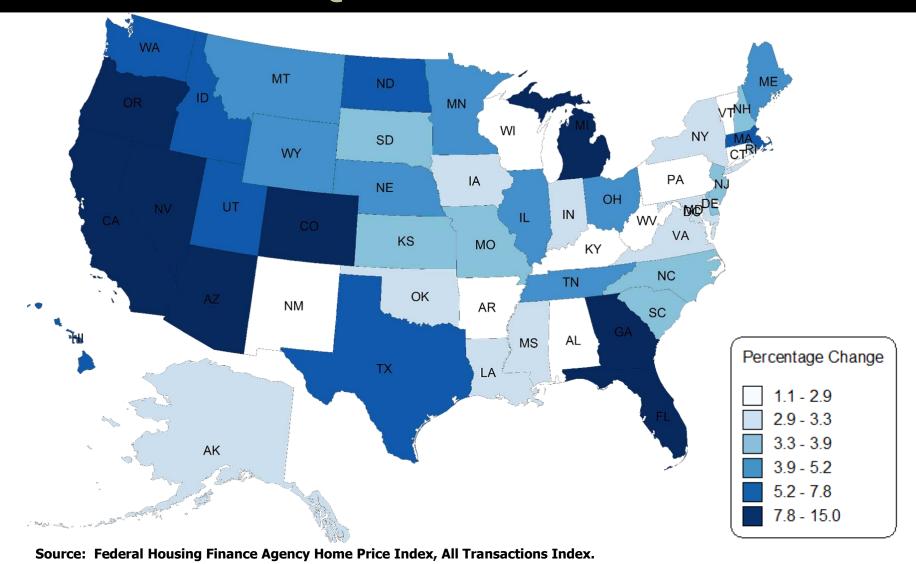

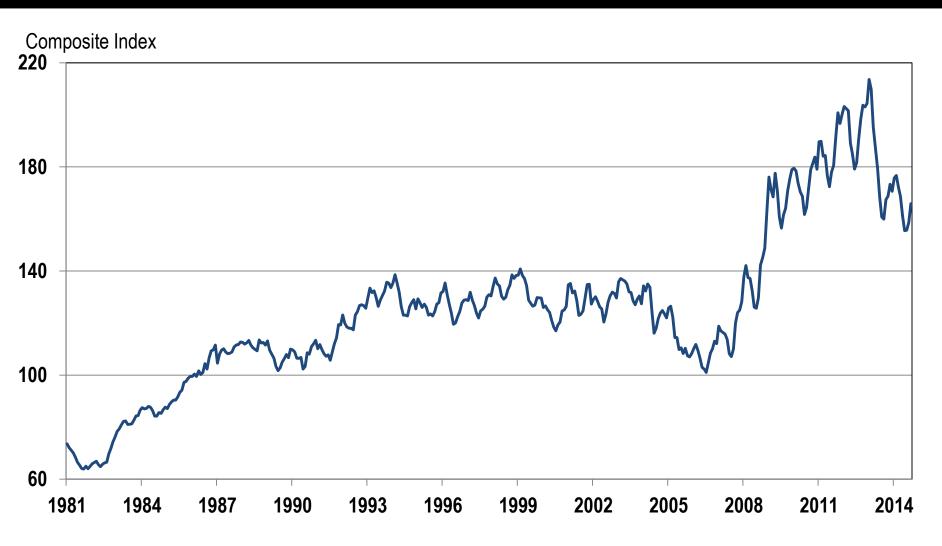

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National FHFA Home Price Growth Year over Year Q3 2014



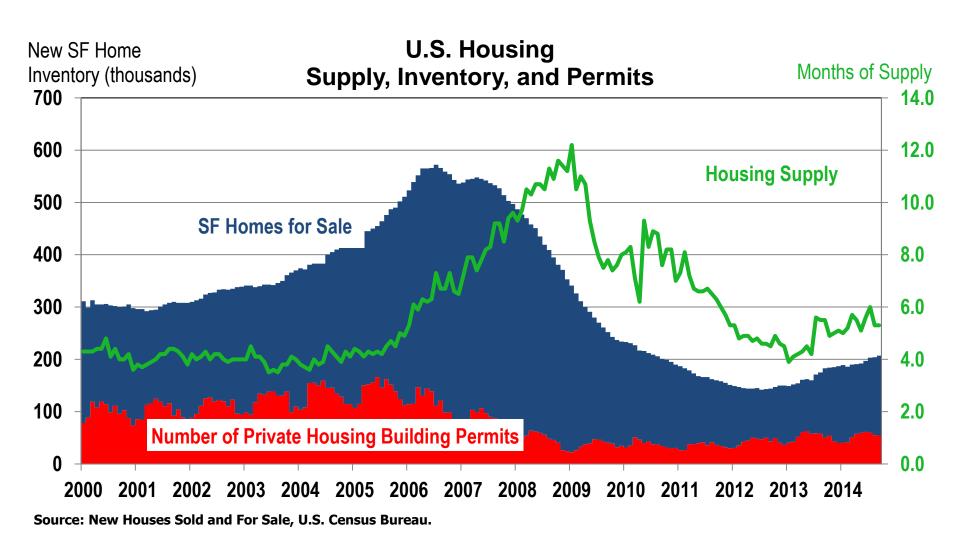
Housing Affordability Index



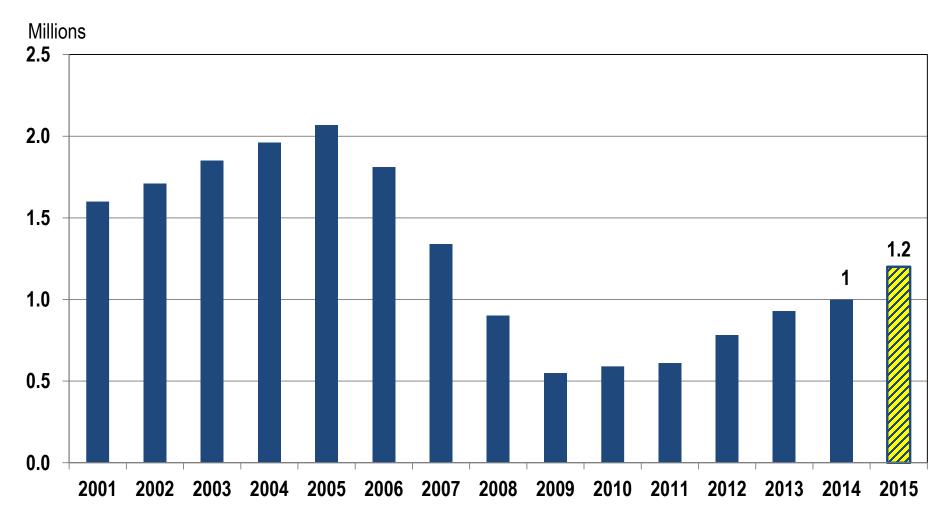

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U.S. Housing — Supply, Inventory, and Permits

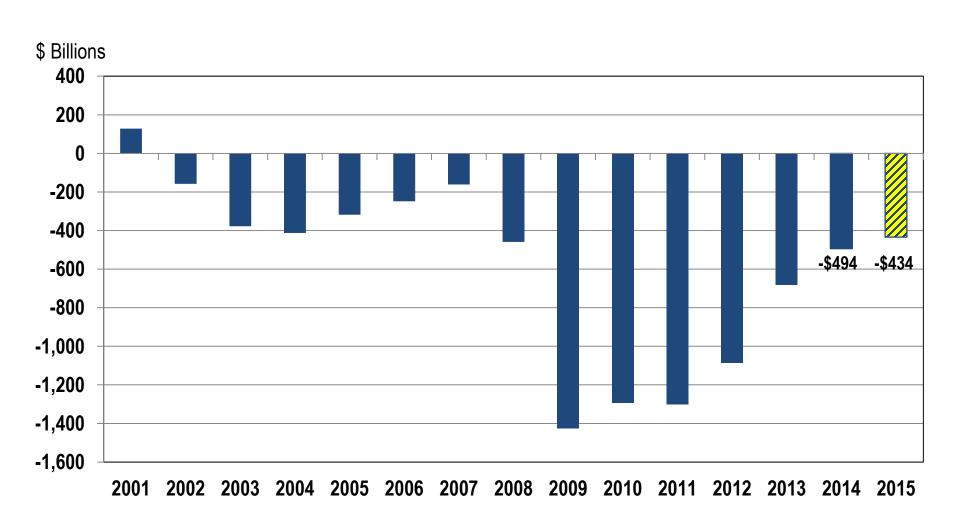


National Housing Starts

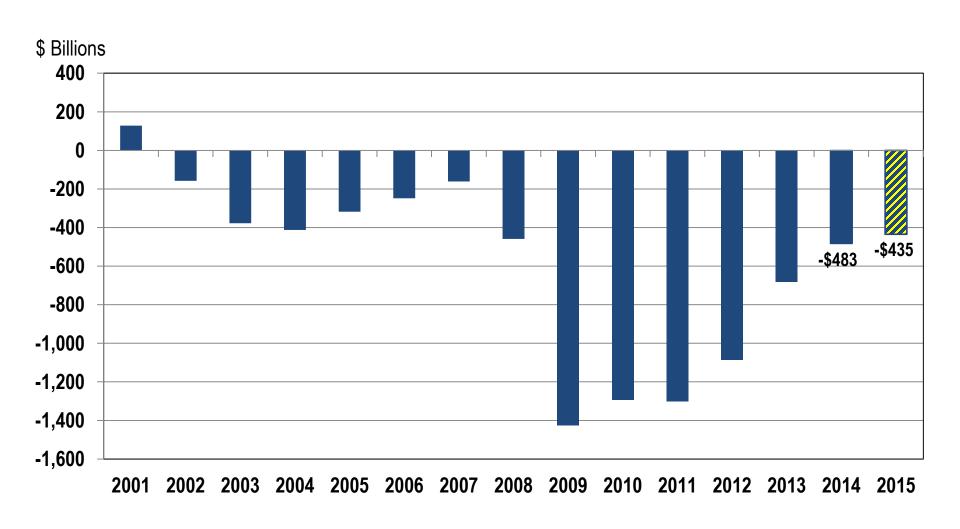
Federal Budget Balance

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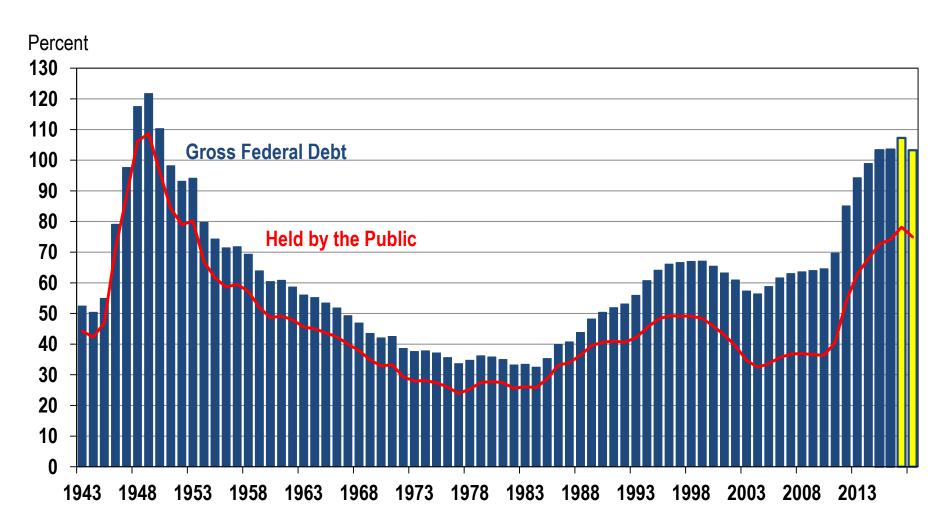

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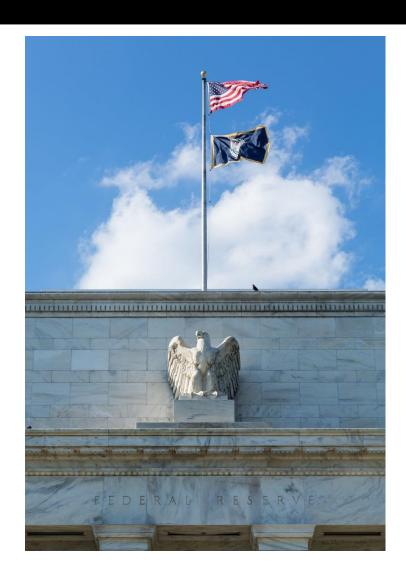
Federal Debt Percentage of GDP

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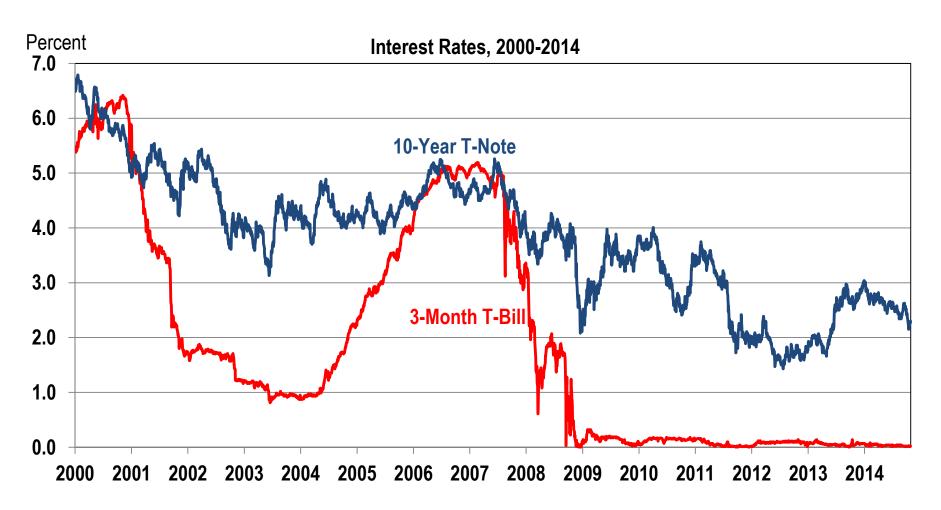

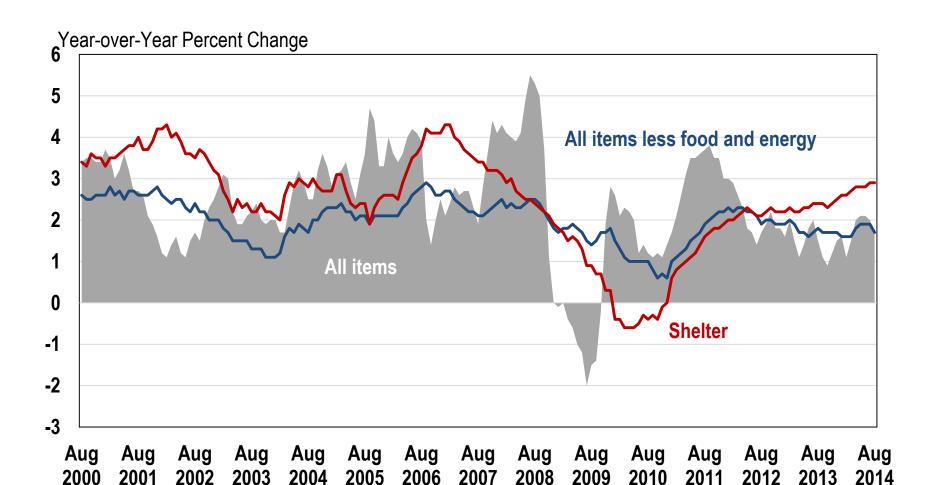

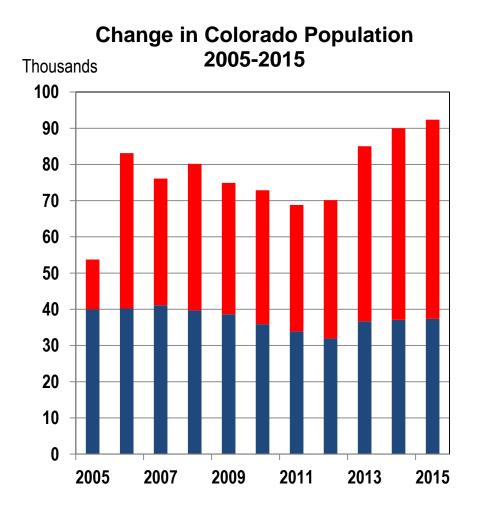

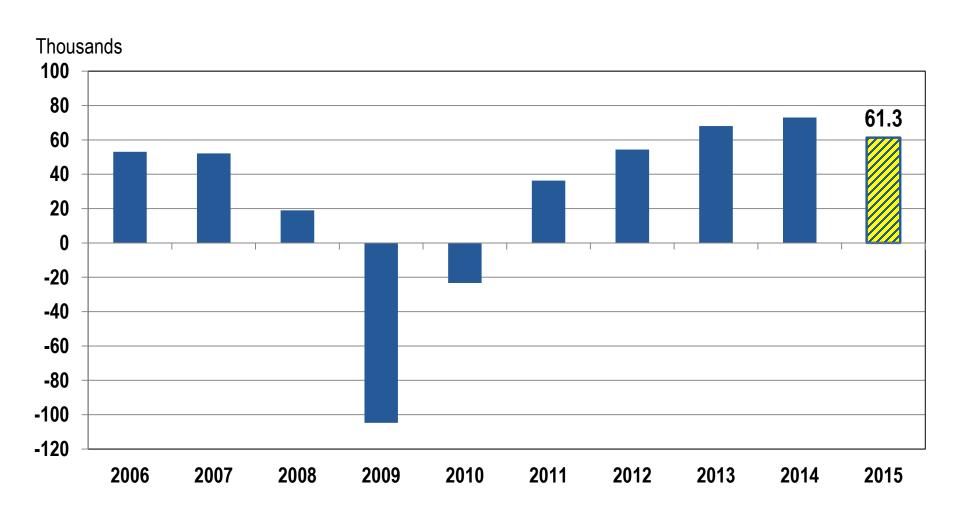

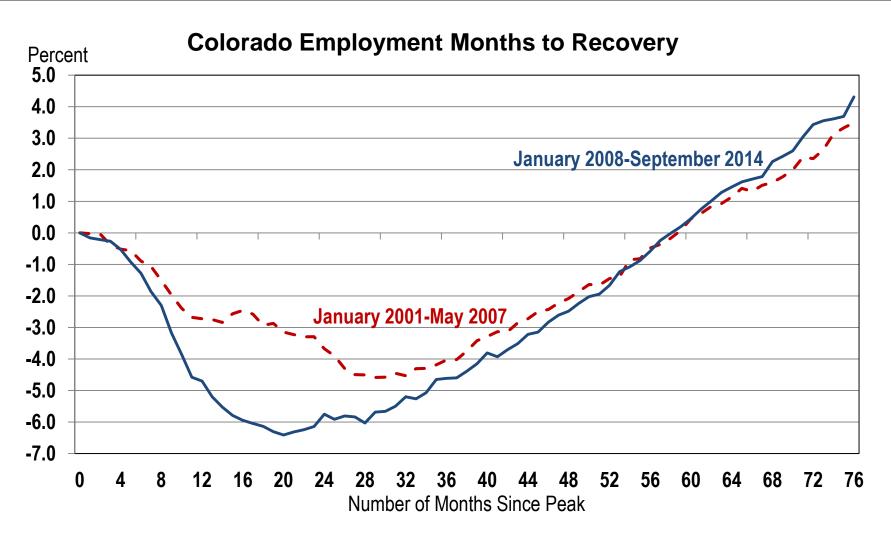
Colorado Employment Growth Jobs Added

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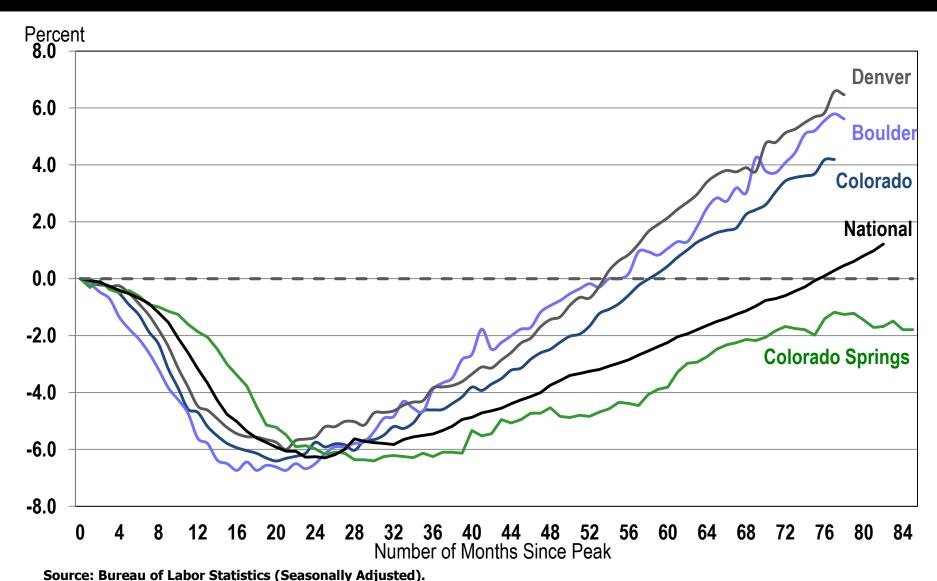
Colorado Employment Months to Recovery



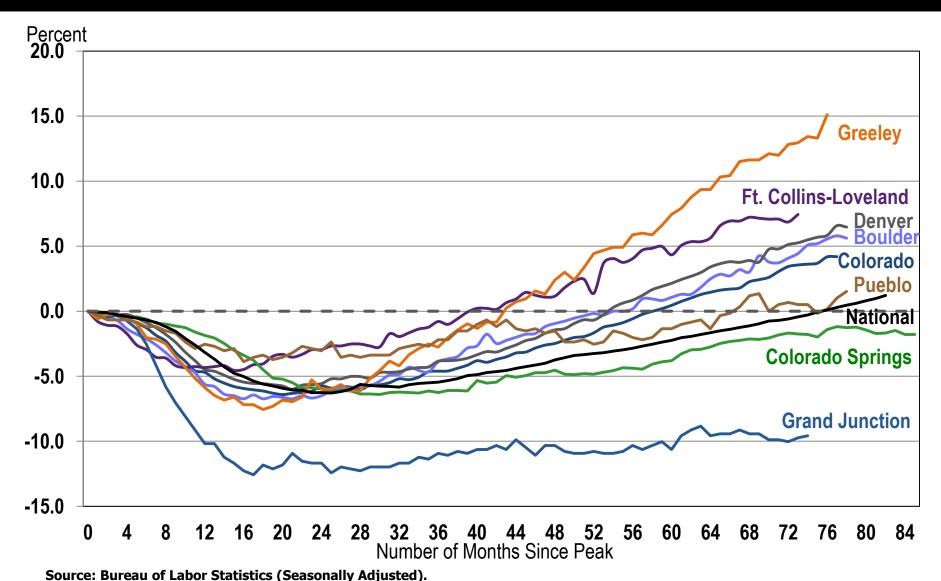

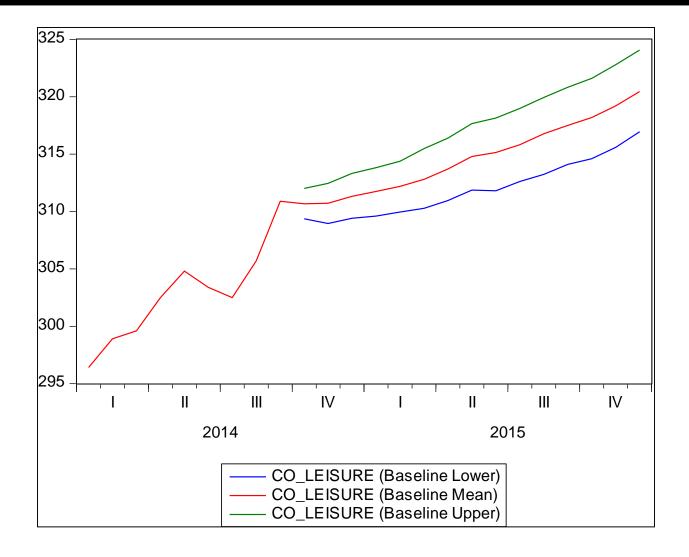
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Employment Recovery National, State, and Local



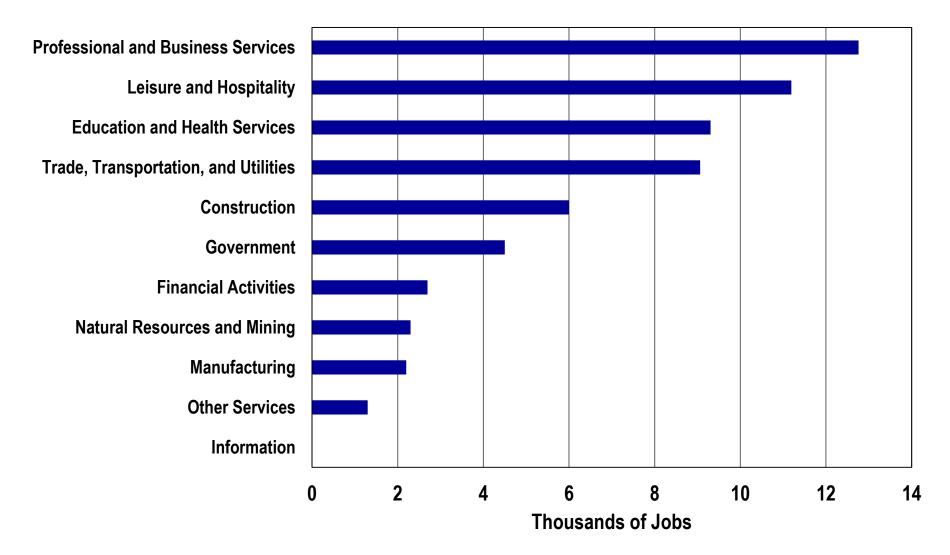

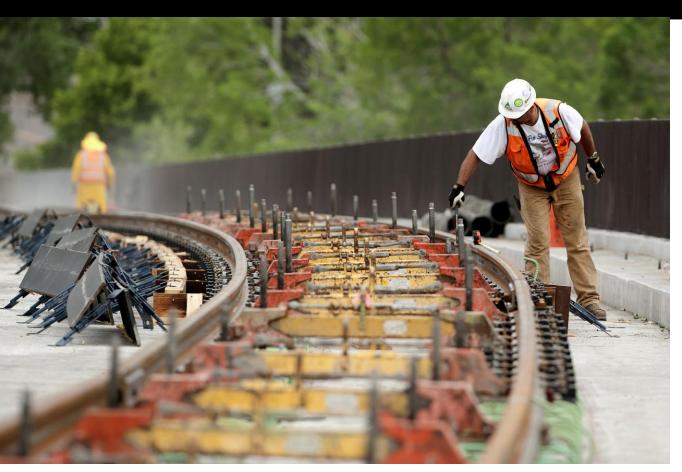

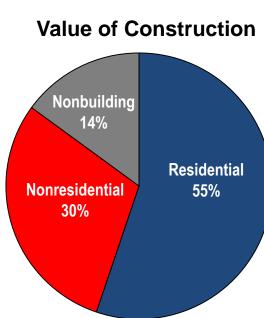
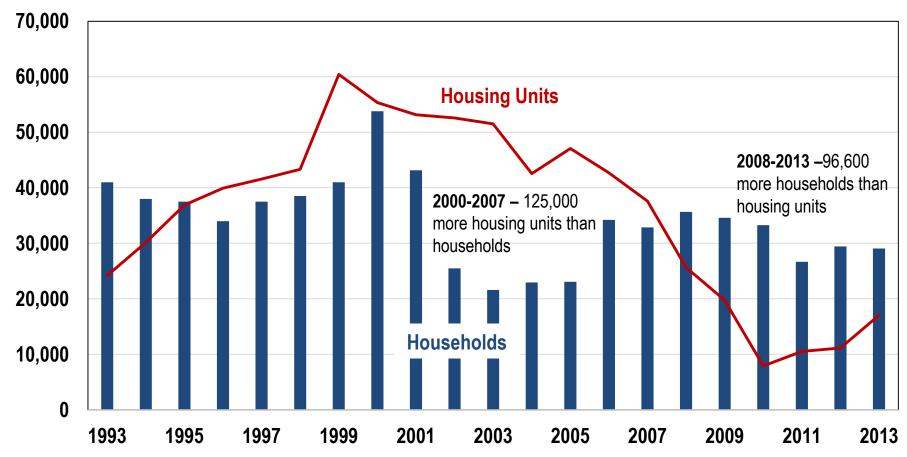

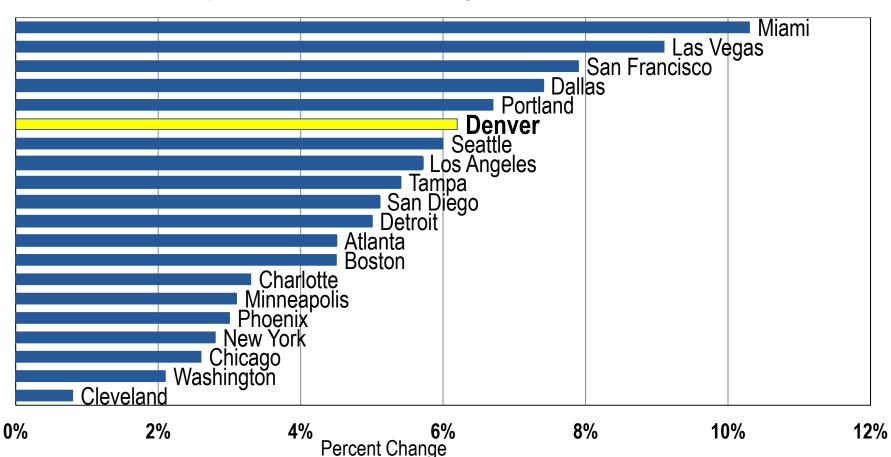
Housing Units vs. Households Annual Change

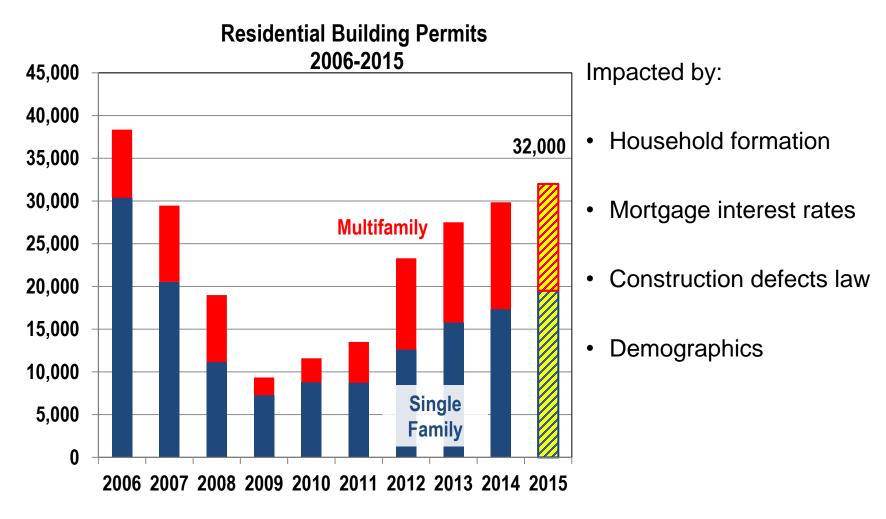
S&P/Case-Shiller Home Price Indices

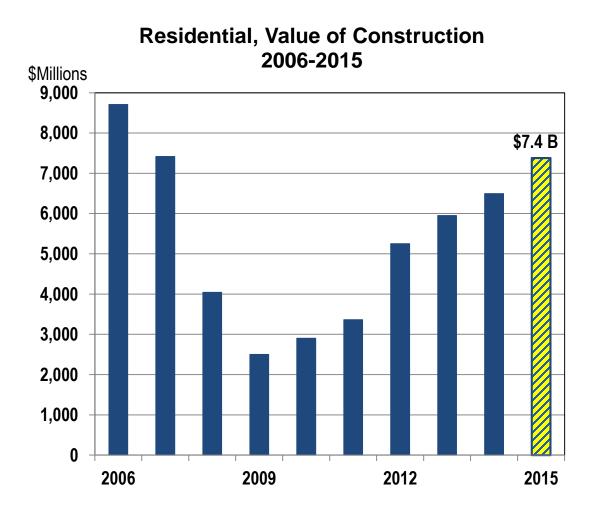

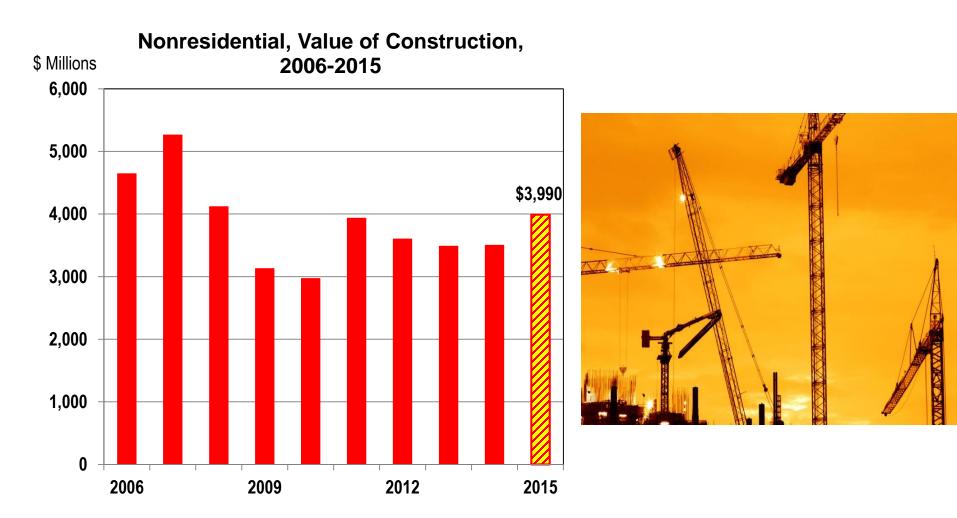
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Value of Construction Residential

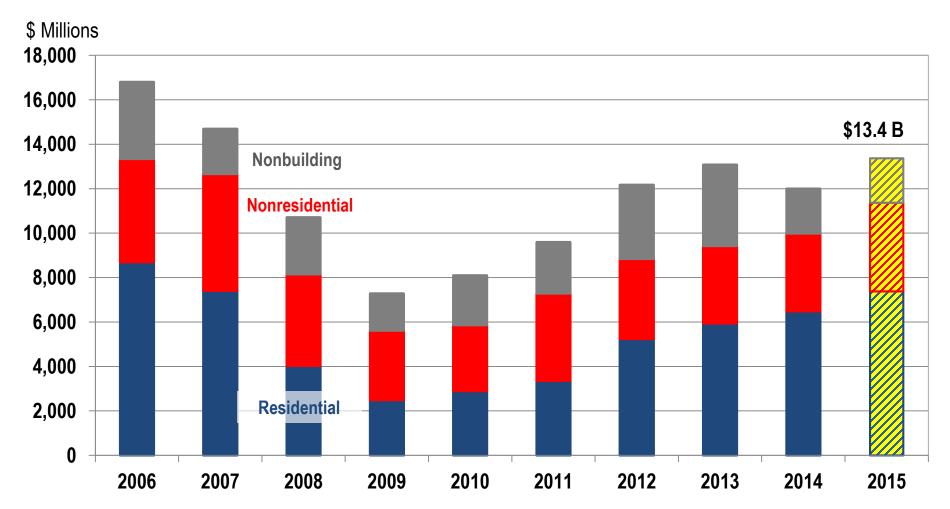
Value of Construction Nonbuilding

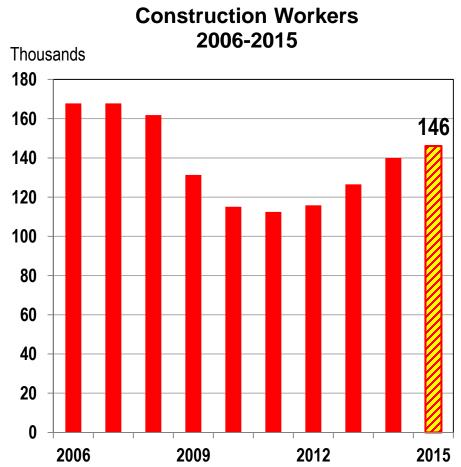

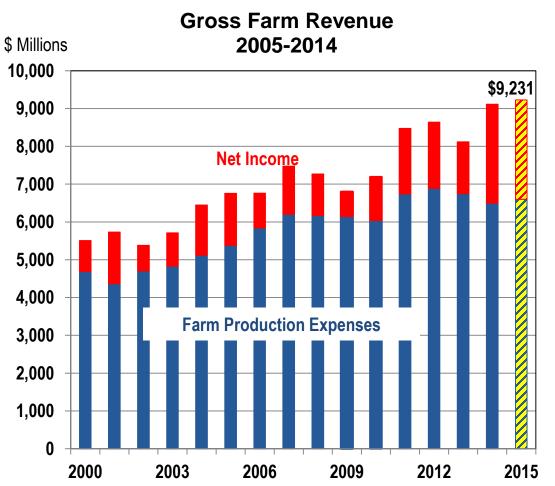

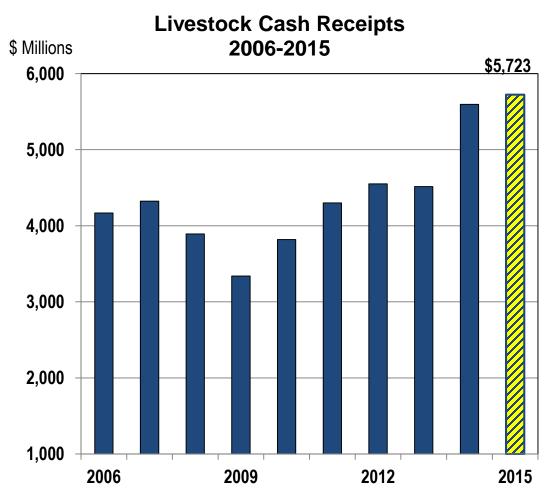
Gross Farm Revenue and Net Income

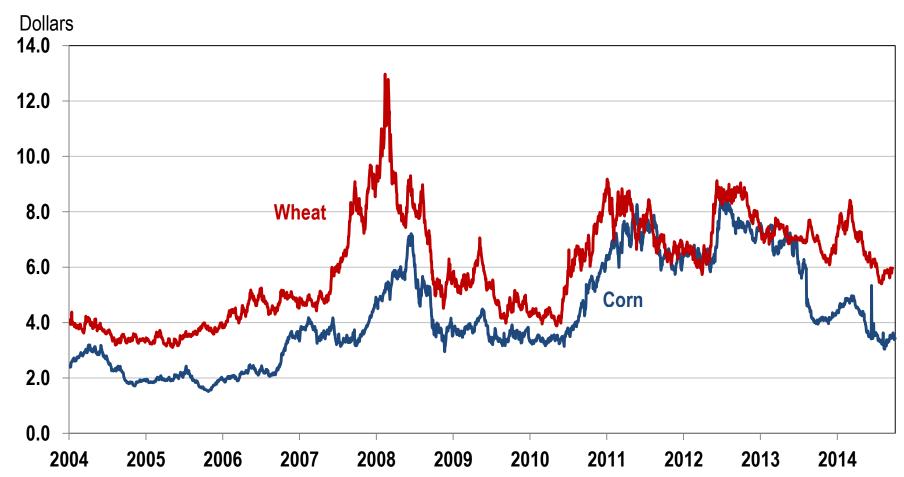

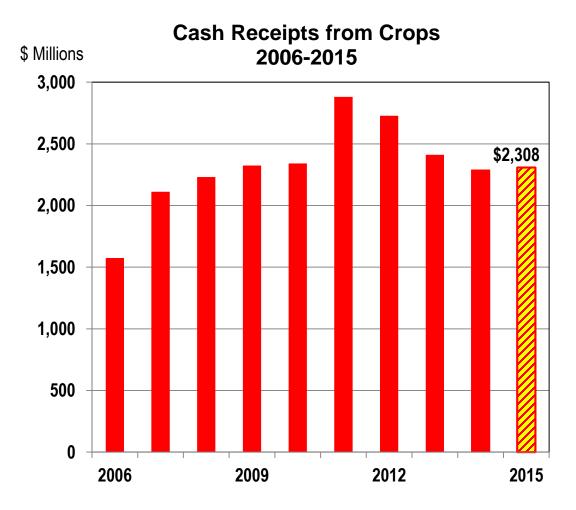
Commodity Prices Wheat and Corn

- Expected to increase less than 1% in 2015

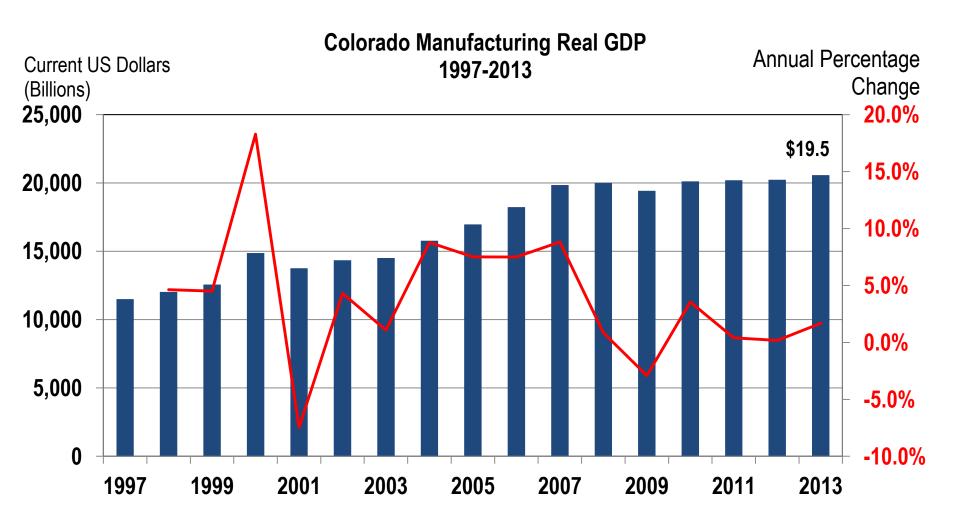

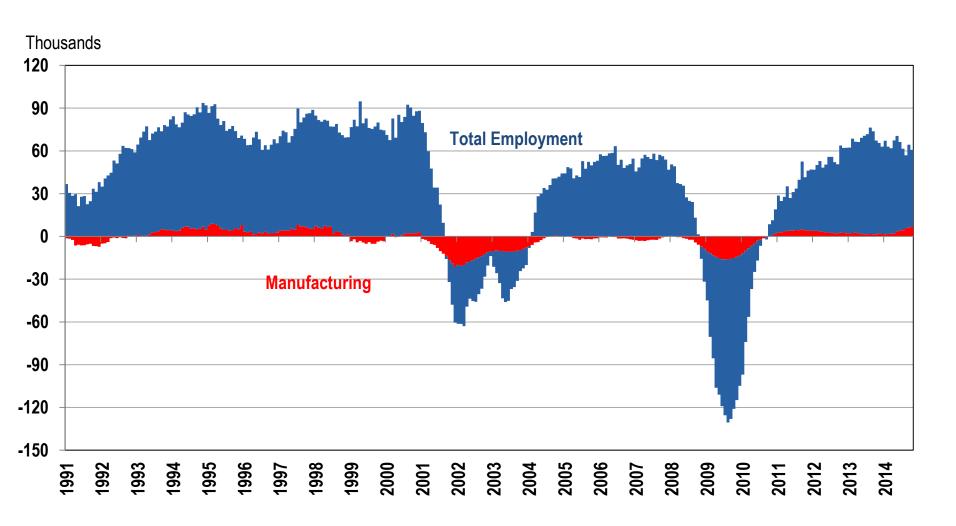
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Manufacturing Real GDP Colorado

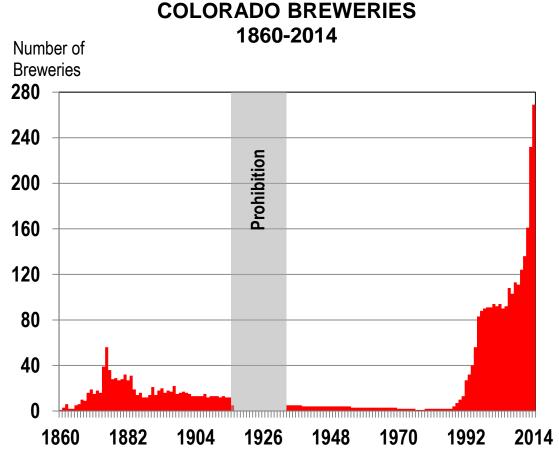

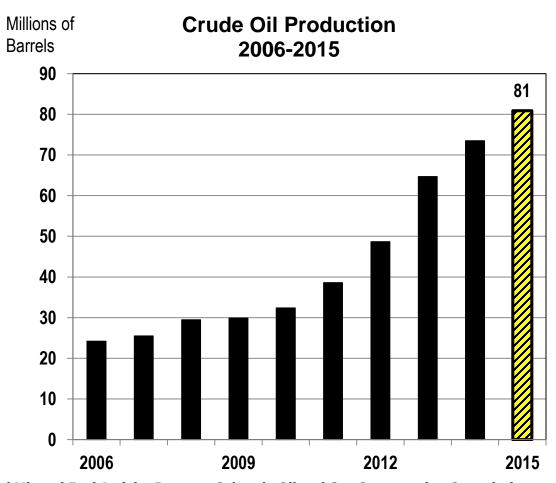


WTI Oil Price



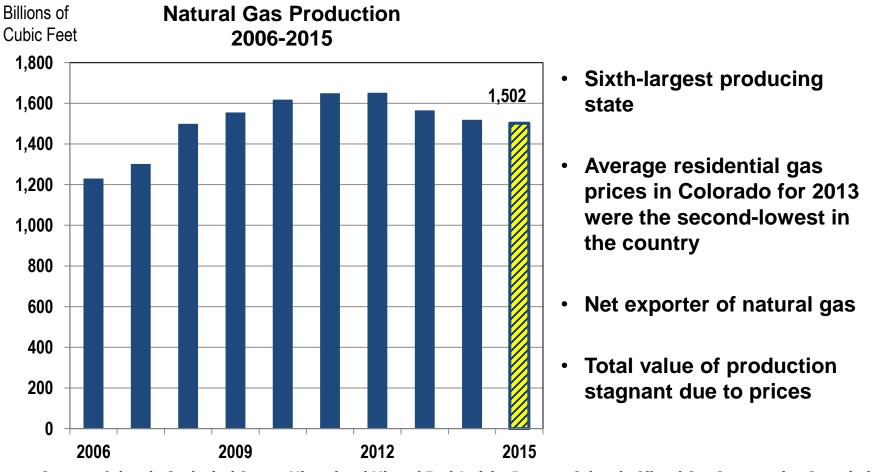

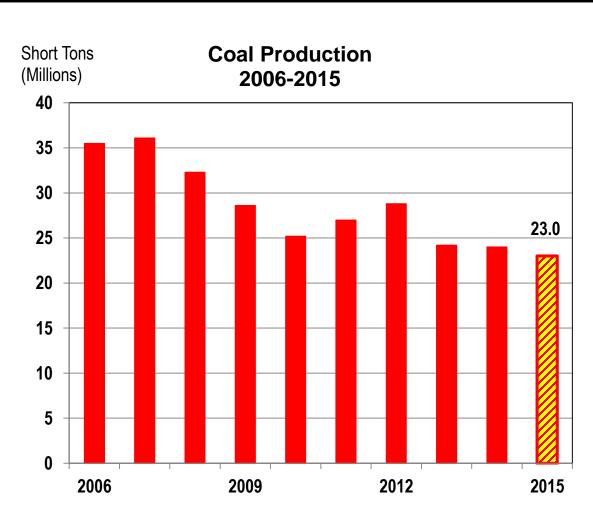
Natural Gas Production

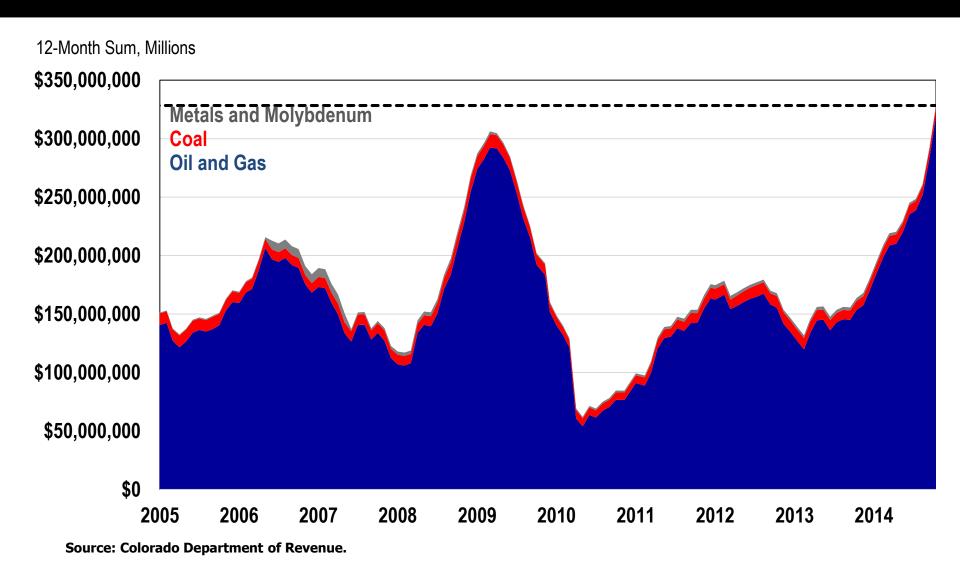
Coal Production

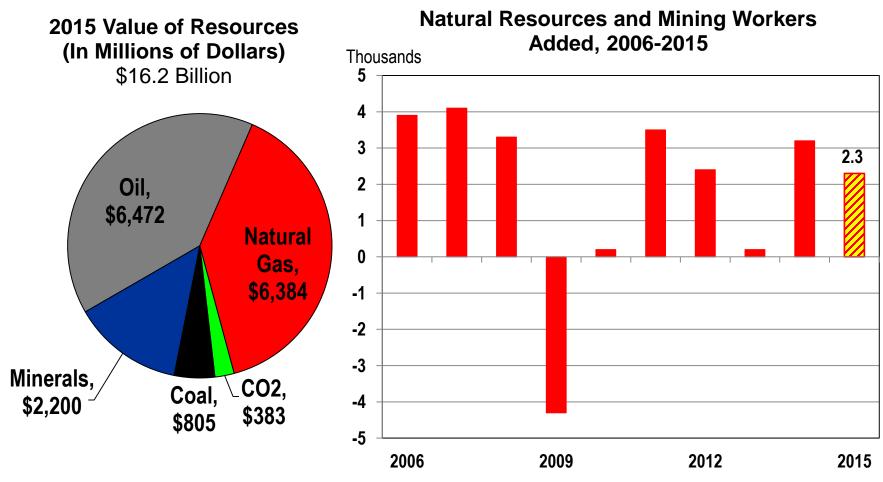


Renewables

- Colorado ranks sixth nationally in renewable energy potential

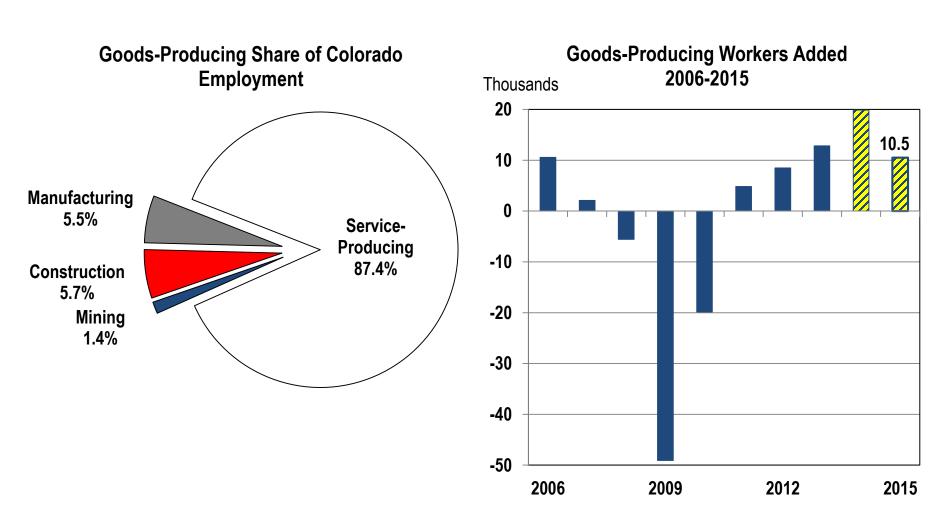


Natural Resources and Mining Valuation and Employment

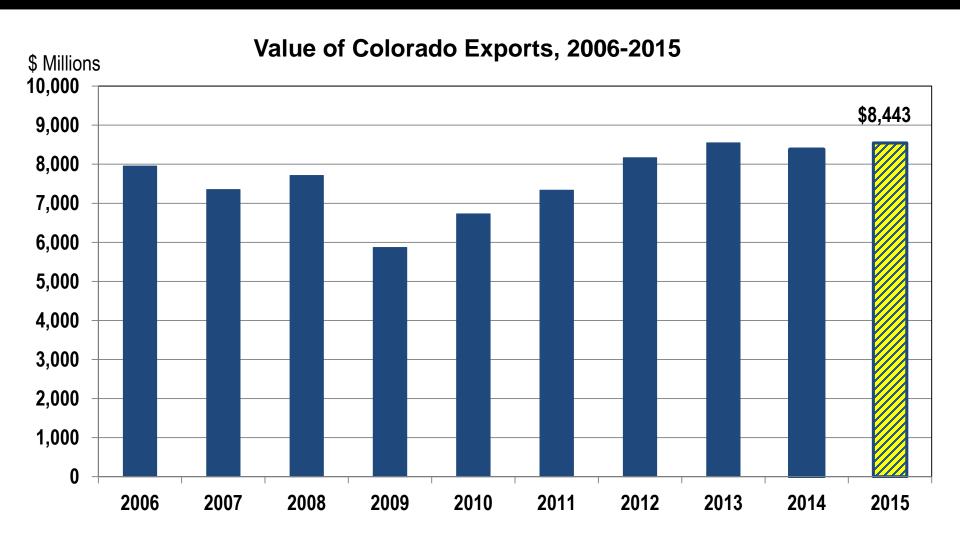

Nominal Broad Dollar Index



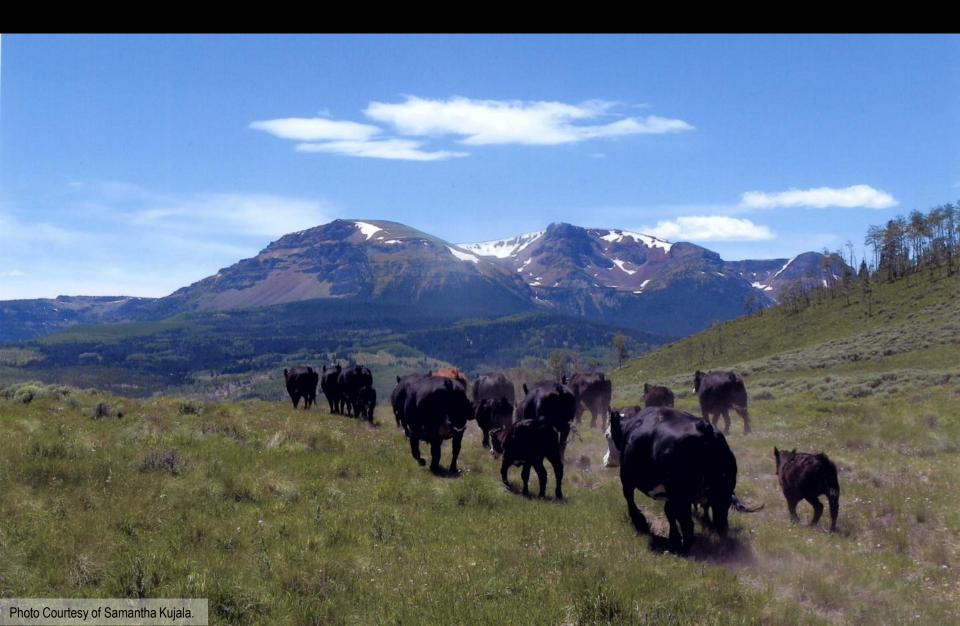

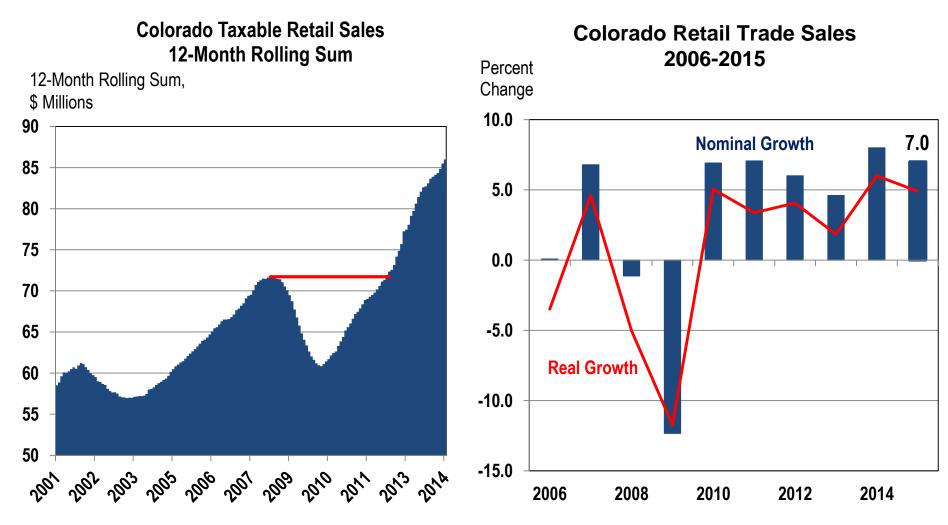

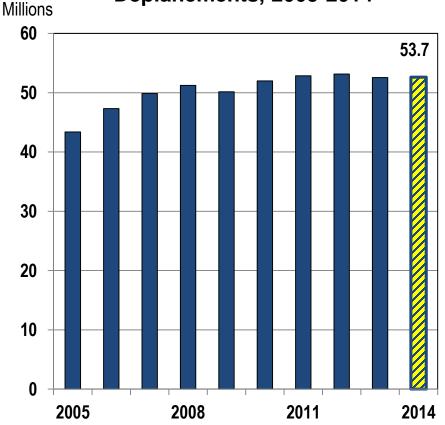

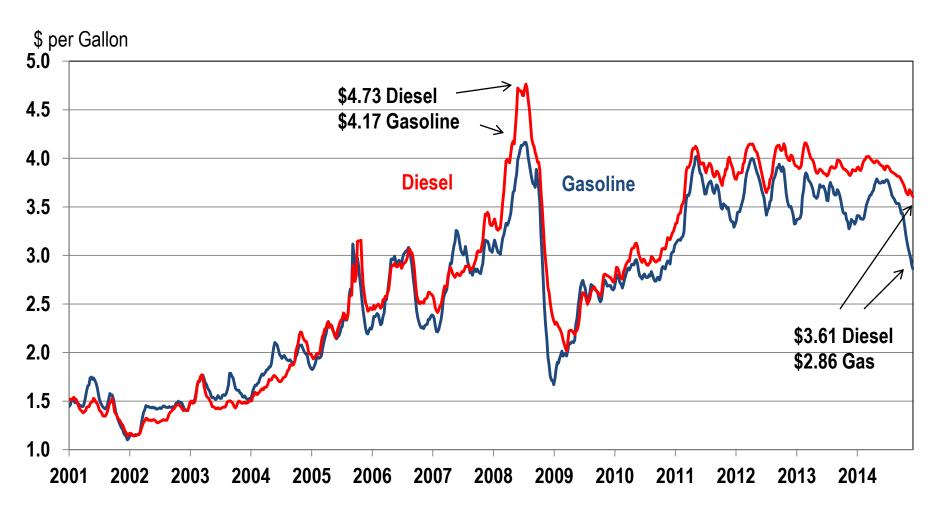

U.S. Retail Gasoline and Diesel Prices



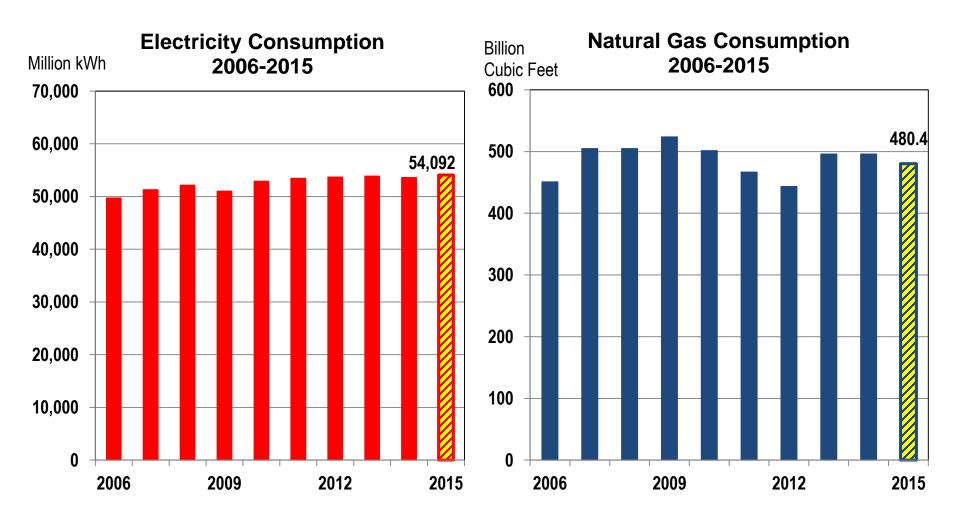

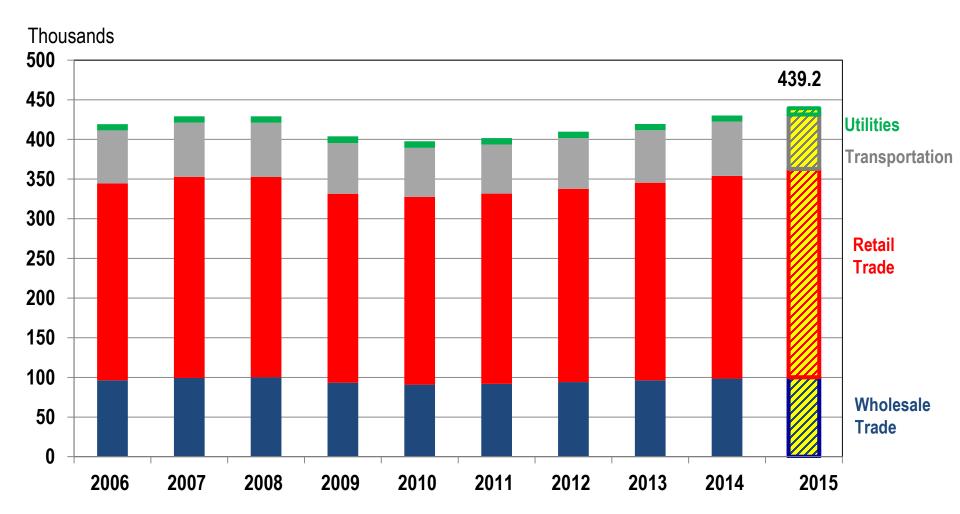

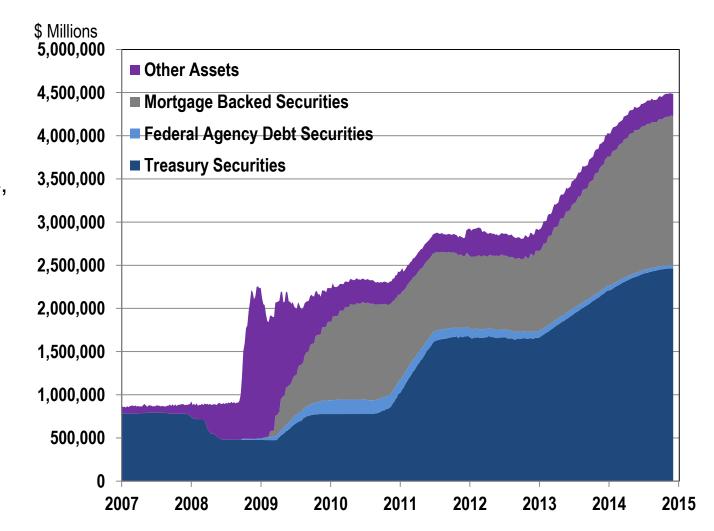

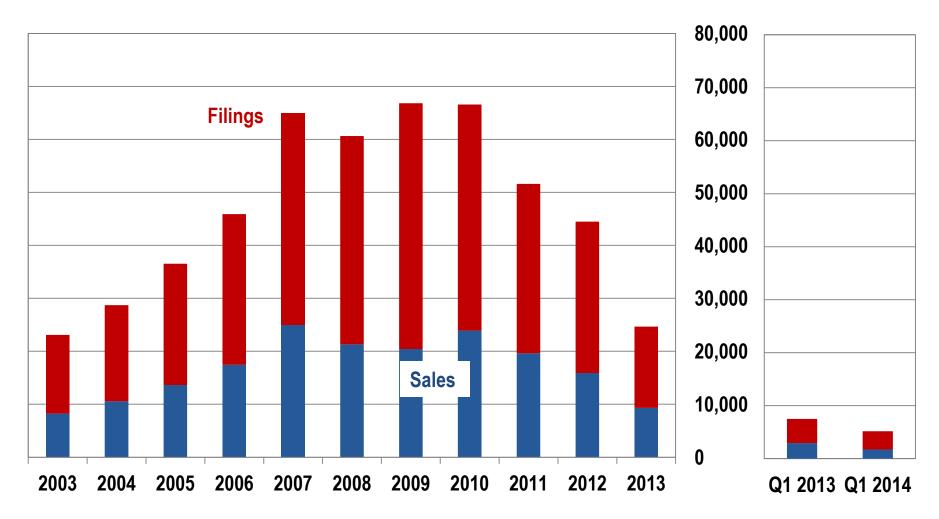

Colorado Foreclosures Filing and Sales

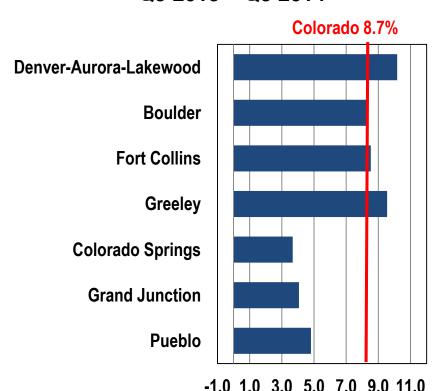

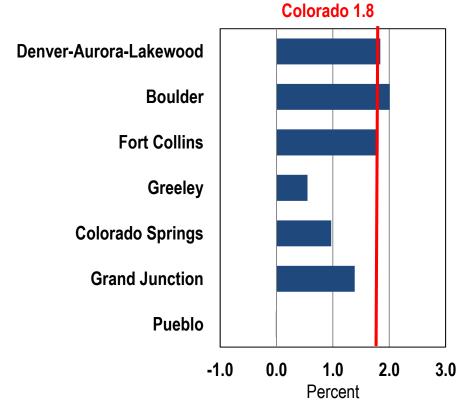

Federal Housing Finance Agency Home Prices by MSA CAGR Q3 2004 – Q3 2014

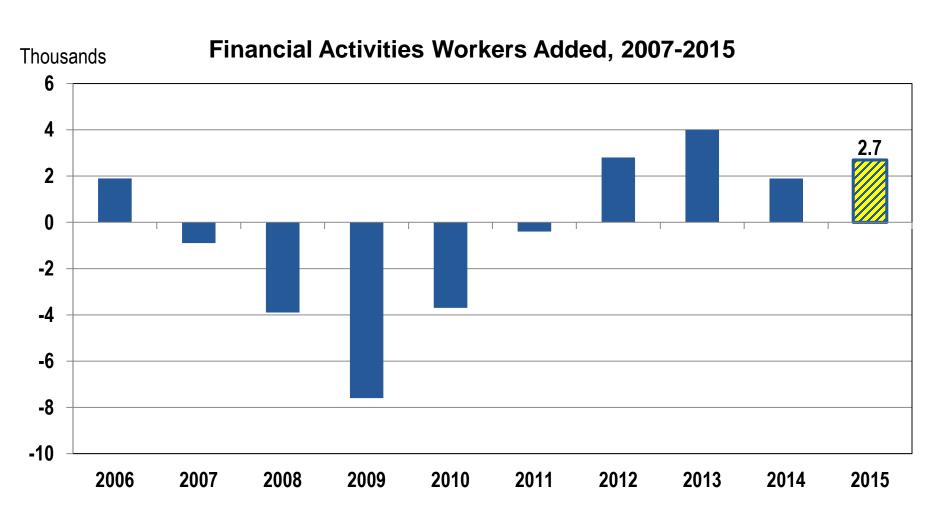

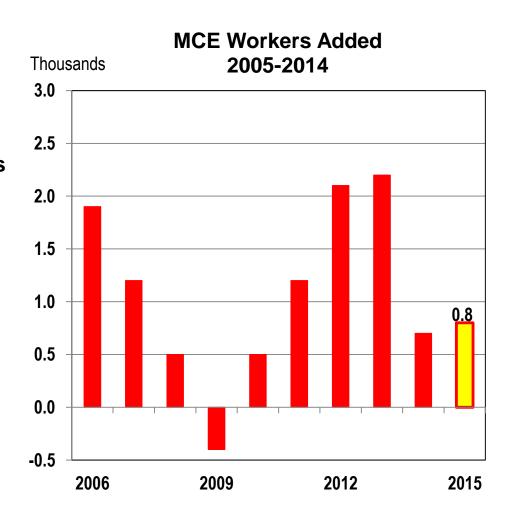

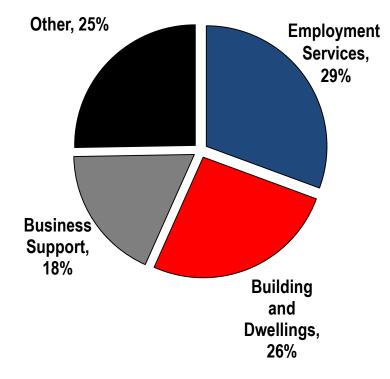

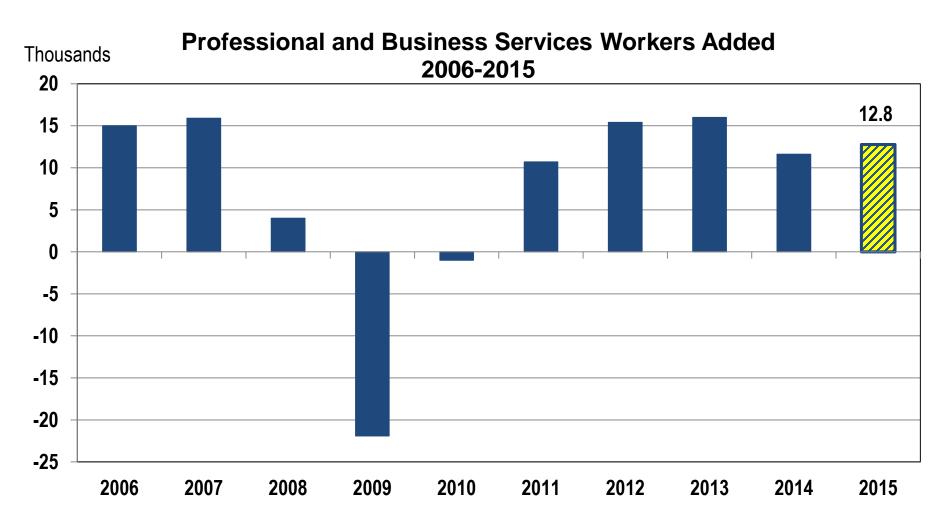


Admin and Waste Services Workers Added 2006-2015

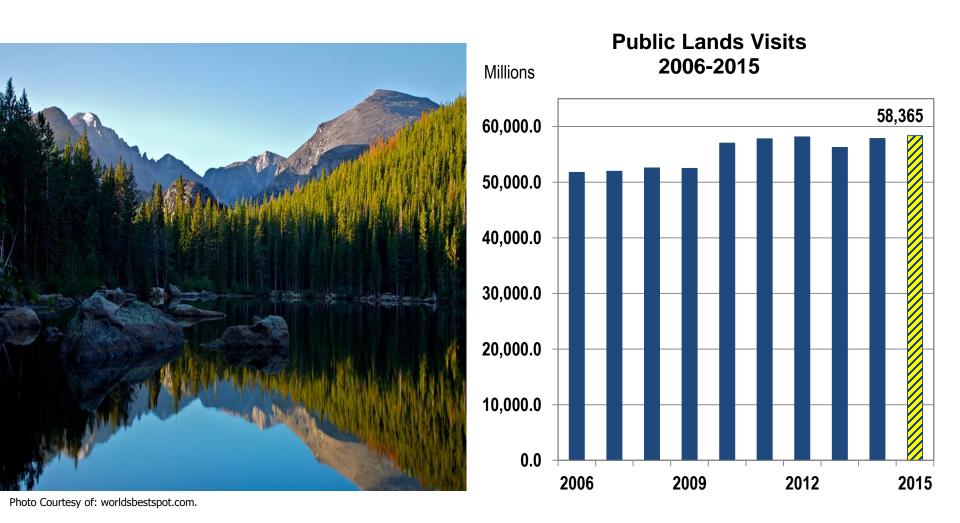

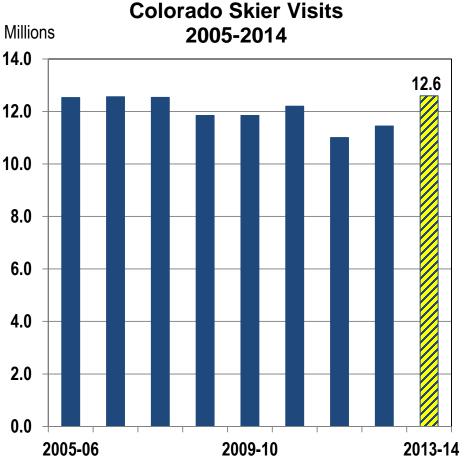

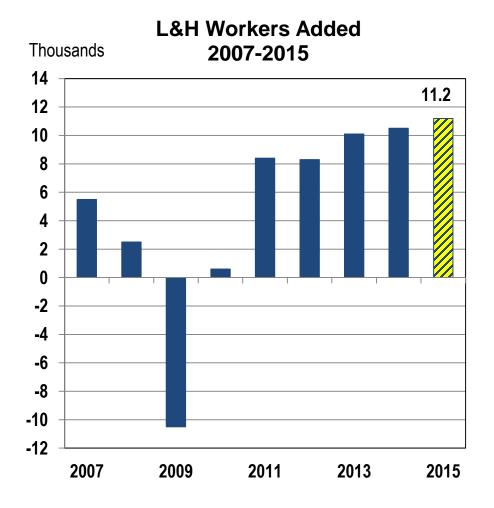

Health Care Services

Health Care Services Employment Growth, Annualized, 2006-2014



- 11% of Colorado jobs
- Consistent employment growth
- PPACA upheld by Supreme Court
- Entitlement enrollment growing
- Insurance coverage expanding

Health Care Services Major Trends



- Labor shortages
- Average annual wage is below Colorado Average
- Continued, sustainable growth expected for many reasons:
 - Aging population
 - Increasing rates of obesity and chronic diseases
 - Increase in the number of persons eligible for health insurance
 - Realignment of care delivery

Health Care Services Occupations

- Timeline for training practitioners is slow, despite increased demand
- Registered nurses are the largest segment of primary care
- Expanded emphasis on primary care expected to increase opportunity for nurses, physician assistants
- Greater need for frontline workers who work on prevention rather than treatment



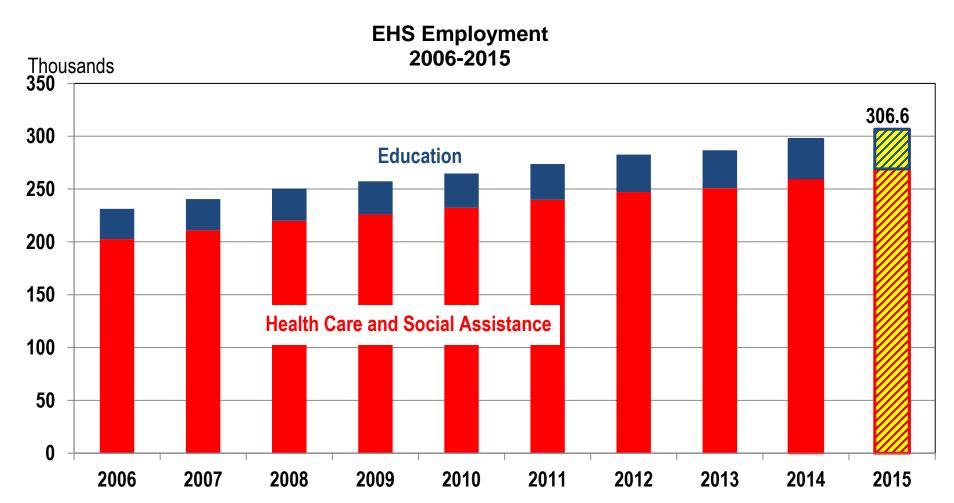
Health Care Services Legislation



- Colorado's uninsured dropped 7.5% during PPACA open enrollment
 - Below national average
- Insurance premiums expected to increase modestly
- Increased adults and children eligible for Medicaid and CHP+
- Increased concerns over whether there are enough providers to handle new Medicaid patients

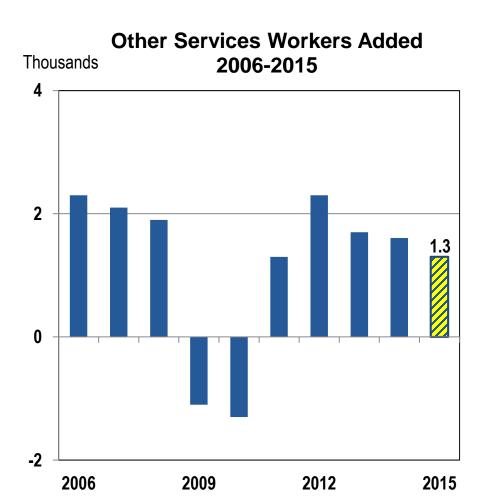

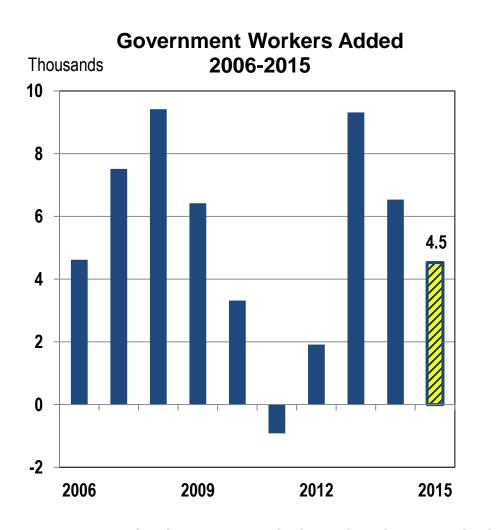

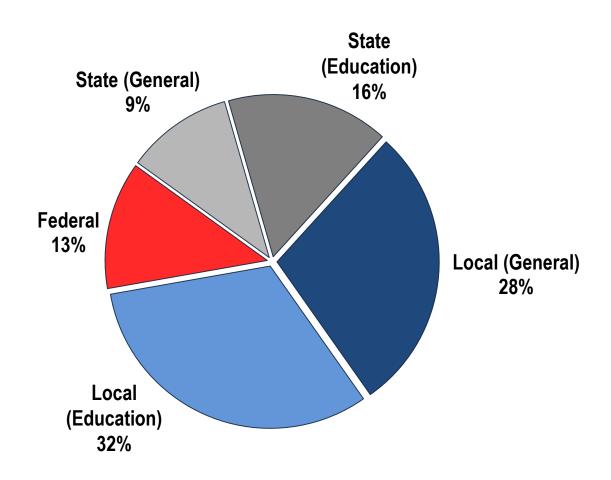

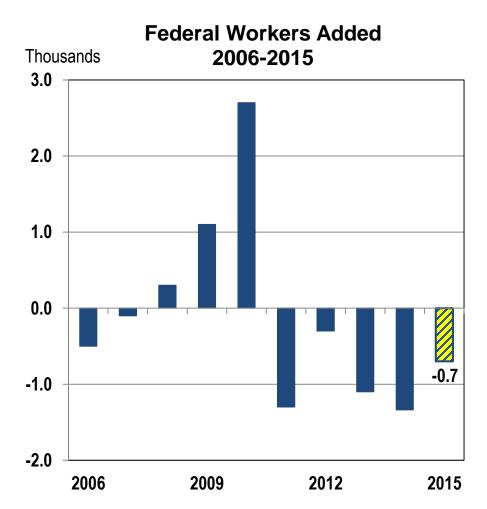

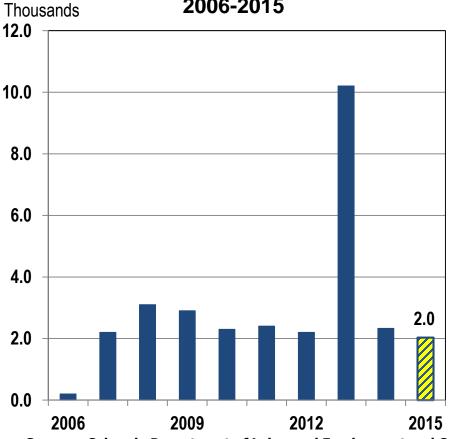

State Government Workers Added nds 2006-2015



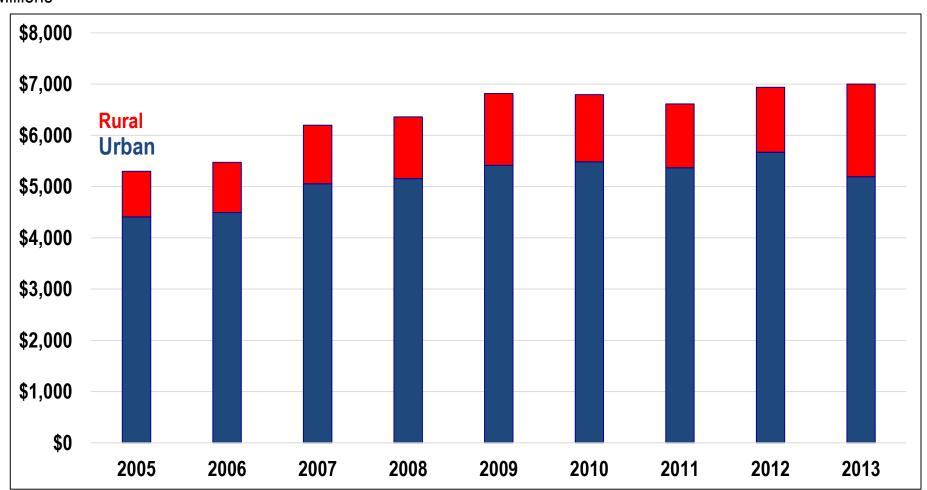

Colorado Property Tax Revenue By Counties

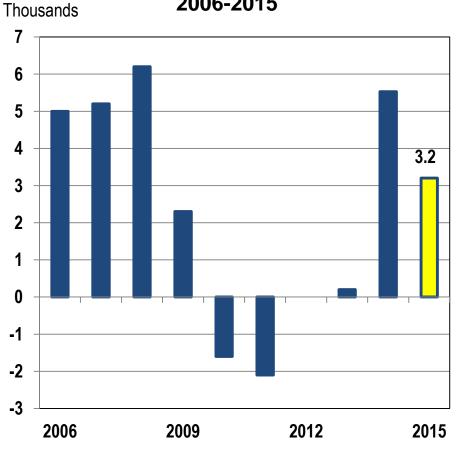

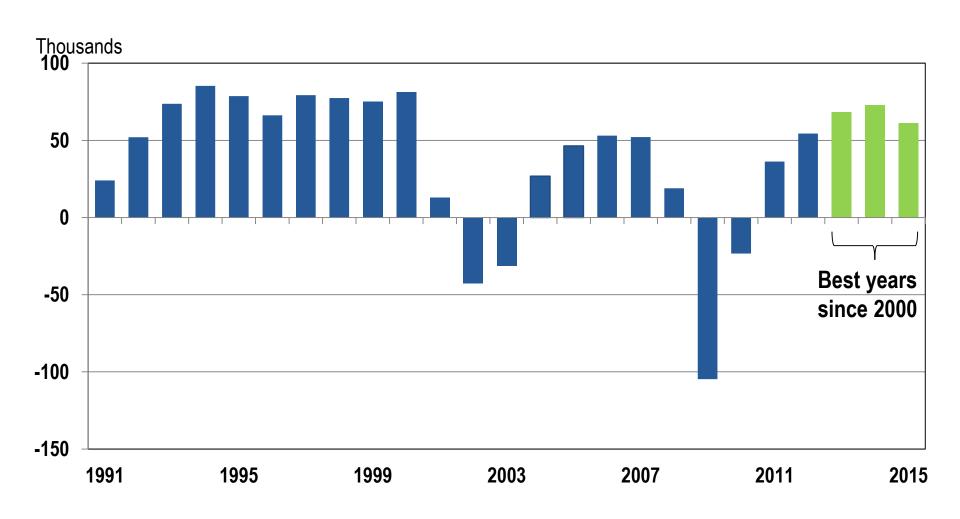
