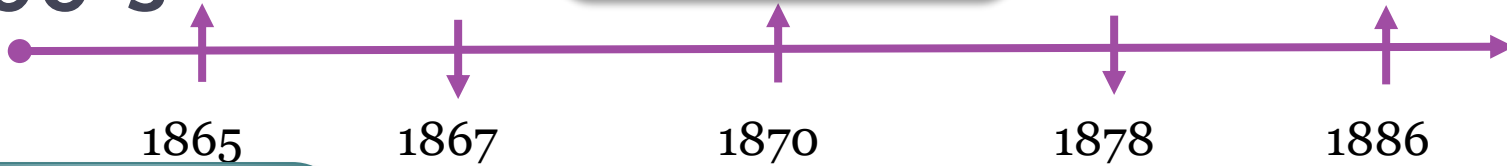
1865: Territorial Assembly passed an act regulating toll roads.
